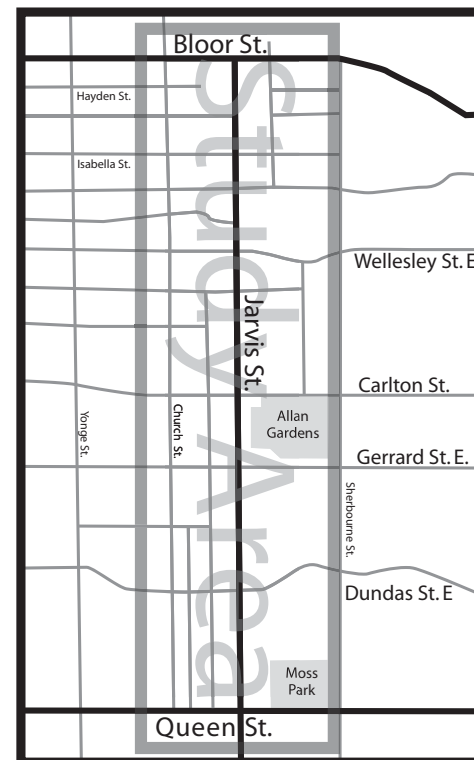

MUNICIPAL CLASS ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT — NOTICE OF STUDY COMMENCEMENT

The Study Objective

The City of Toronto has started a Class Environmental Assessment (EA) to study and develop streetscape improvement plans and traffic lane modifications along the Jarvis Street corridor from Bloor Street East to Queen Street East, as shown in the map. The study will be an opportunity for the public to provide input into a design concept for Jarvis Street that will meet the aesthetic and historic objectives of the area, improve the streetscaping features and address operational issues along the corridor.

The Study Process

The study is being undertaken in accordance with the Municipal Engineers Association guidelines for a Schedule 'C' Class Environmental Assessment (EA). The Class EA study will define the problems and opportunities, consider and evaluate alternative solutions and design concepts, and present the evaluation process.

Public Participation

Public consultation is a vital component to this study. Two public meetings will be held for the general public to receive your input, comments and concerns on the study findings and recommendations. At the first public meeting and open house we will present the statement of issues for the project, a list of alternative solutions, the evaluation criteria for each alternative and the preliminary preferred alternative. Representatives from the City of Toronto and the project consultants will be present to answer questions and discuss next steps.
