

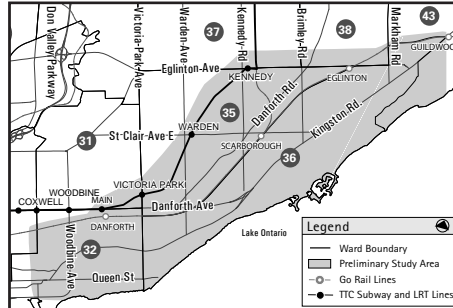


Kingston Road Transit Improvements Environmental Assessment – Open Houses

NOTICE OF STUDY COMMENCEMENT & TERMS OF REFERENCE

Background

The City of Toronto and the Toronto Transit Commission (TTC) will be conducting a study that will look at ways to improve transit service along Kingston Road, between Victoria Park Avenue and Eglinton Avenue. The study will be carried out as an individual Environmental Assessment under Ontario's Environmental Assessment Act. The Act requires that a Terms of Reference be prepared. The Terms of Reference guides the study and outlines the project background, the study process, issues to be addressed, and the public consultation plan.
