## Proposed Transit Improvements – Park Lawn to Long Branch

### New Consultation Process – Notice of Public Meetings

The TTC and City of Toronto are re-starting the planning and consultation for the Waterfront West Transit project on Lake Shore Boulevard West. We want to hear from you. Two “preliminary planning” public meetings will be held to ensure the community is well informed and a constructive dialogue can begin.

The City and TTC look forward to meeting with the community to work towards a design concept that will support local goals and objectives and provide high quality, reliable, transit service in the future. The Transit City program objectives and plan to replace the existing streetcars with new, longer and accessible vehicles in the near future will form the basis of the discussion.

#### Meeting Format

Each meeting will include a presentation, question and answer period, and facilitated small group discussions to ensure everyone has a chance to participate. Some of the issues to be discussed include: new vehicles to replace streetcars, location of transit stops, use of a dedicated right of way, streetscape upgrades, accessibility, and other topics related to transit.

The preliminary consultation meetings will be held on two days with an afternoon and evening session on each day. The presentation, Q and A, and round table discussions will take place at the evening session. The afternoon sessions will allow the public to review background material related to the Transit City program and clarify the design elements of light rapid transit service. Details are as follows:

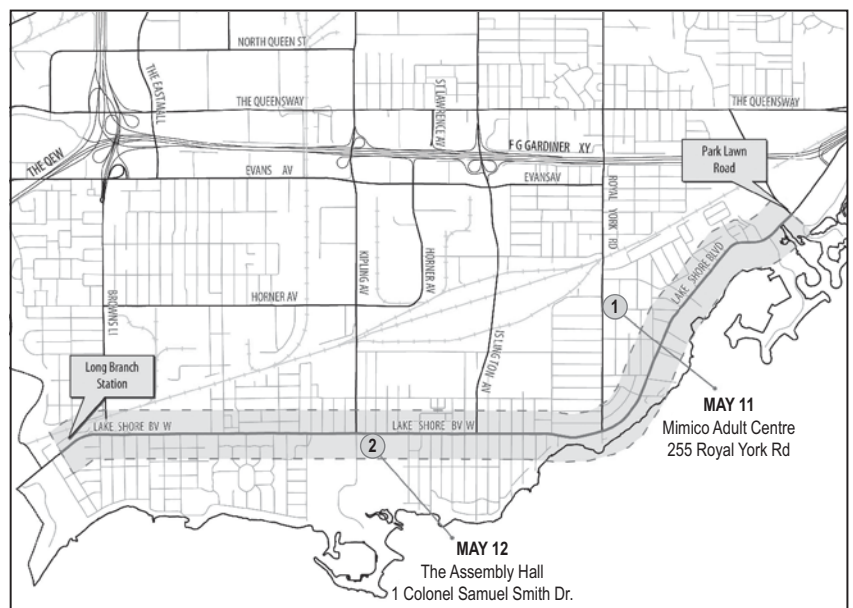
