Project Background

The existing trunk watermain that runs from the Rosehill Pumping Station at 240 Mount Pleasant Road to Bayview Avenue and Parkhurst Boulevard does not have sufficient capacity to meet projected water demands. Therefore, a larger watermain needs to be constructed.

This study is being carried out as a Schedule 'B' project under the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (June 2000) process.

Public Consultation

Public consultation is an important part of any environmental assessment study. Your involvement in our study is welcome.

The first open house was held on December 5, 2006, to introduce the study, the preliminary route alternatives and the evaluation criteria to be used for selection of the preferred route.
