IMPORTANT MEETING for SRT Extension

City of Toronto will hold a Residents Meeting to discuss the proposed extension of the **Scarborough Rapid Transit (SRT)** on **Thursday July 31, 2008** at the **Malvern Recreation Centre (Community Room)**, at **30 Sewells Road** (east of Neilson Road)
Presentation will begin at 7:00 p.m.
Presentation boards will be available for review between 6:30 and 7:00 p.m.

Dear Resident,

The City of Toronto and the TTC are assessing ways to significantly improve transit service to the north and east of Scarborough City Centre. Planning for this project includes:

- Amending the approved 1992 Scarborough Rapid Transit Extension EA for an extension from McCowan Station to the Markham/Sheppard area;
- A new Class EA for higher order transit beyond Sheppard to Malvern.

This service would:

- Best support population and employment growth by providing the most reliable transit service to Malvern
- Provide a fast and high quality, no transfer service for passengers traveling between Malvern and Kennedy Station and all points between
- Improve transit service to Centennial college
- Accommodate future increases in ridership demand associated with growth in the study area and allow for a future extension to the northeast to connect to other proposed transit services

To date, two rounds of public open houses have been held. At the second round on June 4 and 5, alignment options were presented for the extension of the SRT from McCowan Station, to the vicinity of Malvern Town Centre. A detailed analysis is currently being performed on each of these alignments, with the intent of recommending a preferred alignment for presentation at a public meeting in August.

Community Involvement: - The attached drawing illustrates the routing of Alignment N3 and as you will note, this alignment is in the vicinity of your home. In light of this, a special meeting is being convened with residents that may be affected by this alignment, where TTC and City staff will explain the study process. This will provide residents the opportunity to raise any questions with regard to this alignment, and to understand the process of evaluating and selecting a preferred alignment.
