

Sheppard Avenue East Sewer Upgrades

Projected Start: Monday, Dec 7 *
Projected Finish: Early January 2010 *

* Timelines are subject to change due to weather and/or unforeseen events

Update

Watermain upgrades were successfully completed from October 24-26 and from November 14-16. The final stage of work involves upgrades to the sewer system and will occur in a 100m stretch just west of the Scunthorpe Road and Sheppard Avenue intersection. The City of Toronto and TTC encourage the community to continue to support local businesses throughout construction. Purpose of the Project

The work will extend the service life of the sewers in order to minimize maintenance and life-cycle costs in advance of the Sheppard Avenue East Light Rail Transit (LRT) project.

Traffic Restrictions

Sheppard Avenue East

- At least one lane will be maintained in both directions (eastbound and westbound).

Overall Update

All watermain and sewer construction in the 100m stretch west of Scunthorpe Road is scheduled to be completed in **early January**. Staff appreciates your patience during this important work.

Work Hours

Work will generally take place from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm. However, the contractor does have permission to work overnight in order to finish the work as quickly as possible and to minimize traffic disruption. When work occurs overnight, all necessary steps will be taken to minimize noise.
