Public Meeting Cancelled

Bluffer's Park and Harrison Estates Park Trail Improvements

On July 13, 2011, City Council voted to remove the Bluffers Park, Harrison Estates Park and Grey Abbey Park paths from the multi-year Bikeway Trails Implementation Plan.

Staff have been directed to report back to the Public Works & Infrastructure Committee of Council on these trails in the Fall of 2011. Although the date has not yet been confirmed, the requested report will likely be submitted to Committee in November to allow time for community consultation.

The public meeting that was scheduled for Thursday, July 21, 2011 to discuss Trail Improvements in Bluffer's and Harrison Estates Parks is **CANCELLED**. Public Consultation on the Scarborough Waterfront section of the Bikeway Trails Implementation Plan will be held in the fall of 2011.
