



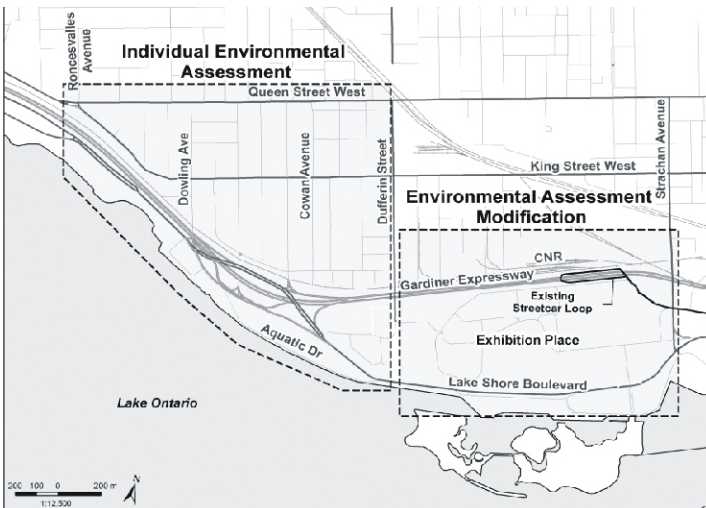

(1) Exhibition Place to Dufferin Street: Environmental Assessment Modification

As part of this study, the TTC is reviewing a number of alternative routes to best extend streetcar service from Exhibition Place to Dufferin Street. The TTC will be presenting preliminary routes and evaluation criteria and indicators for public review and feedback.

(2) Dufferin Street to Roncesvalles Avenue: Individual Environmental Assessment

This section requires undertaking an Individual EA to extend streetcar service from Dufferin Street to the existing tracks at the Roncesvalles Avenue and Queen Street West intersection. The first step of the Individual EA process was the preparation and submission of a Terms of Reference (ToR) to the Minister of the Environment. The ToR was approved by the Minister on July 4th, 2007, and serves as a roadmap for conducting the EA (the second step). The EA study is now underway. After reviewing feedback from the November, 2006 public meetings and conducting additional analysis, the TTC has screened the potential corridors and developed preliminary routes for a new streetcar track route between Dufferin Street and Roncesvalles Avenue.
