Background:

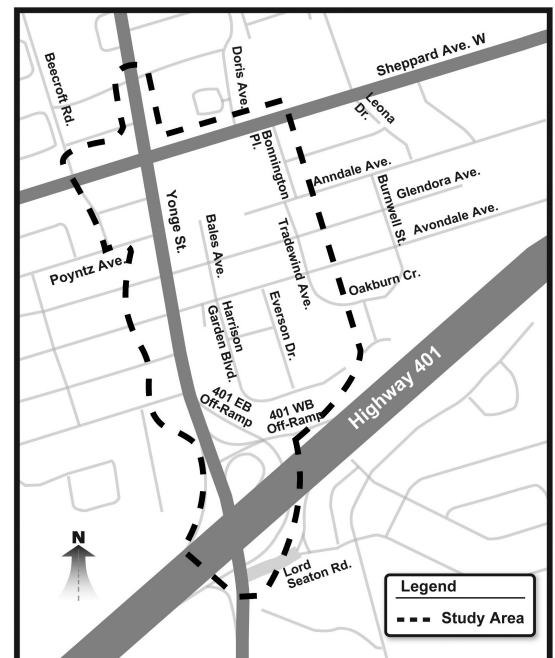
