

GTA Network: A Telecommunications Vision for the GTA

(City Council on November 23, 24 and 25, 1999, adopted this Clause, without amendment.)

The Policy and Finance Committee recommends the adoption of Recommendation No. (1) embodied in the following communication (October 25, 1999) from the City Clerk:

Recommendation:

The Telecommunications Steering Committee:

- (1) recommended to the Policy and Finance Committee that City Council be requested to inform the Greater Toronto Co-ordinating Committee (GTCC) that Council has established a Telecommunications Steering Committee for the purpose of developing a telecommunications strategy for the City of Toronto and for the purpose of coordinating access to and use of the public Rights-of-Way and directing telecommunications activities within the City; and that any course of action that the GTCC wishes to pursue be forwarded to the Telecommunications Steering Committee first to obtain comments as it relates to the City of Toronto; and
- (2) referred the document "GTA Network: A Telecommunications Vision for the GTA" to the Policy and Finance Committee for information.

Background:

The Telecommunications Steering Committee on October 25, 1999, had before it a copy of a report (September 1995) prepared by the Greater Toronto Co-ordinating Committee (GTCC) entitled "GTA Network: A Telecommunications Vision for the GTA", which was forwarded to the Committee by Councillor John Adams, Chair.
