## **Tender for Gasoline and Diesel Fuels**

(City Council on December 14, 15 and 16, 1999, adopted this Clause, without amendment.)

The Administration Committee recommends the adoption of Option B contained in the joint confidential report (November 26, 1999) from the Chief Financial Officer and Treasurer, the Acting Commissioner of Corporate Services, the Medical Officer of Health and the Commissioner of Works and Emergency Services, respecting the results of the tender issued for the supply and delivery of Gasoline and Diesel Fuels which was forwarded to all Members of Council under confidential cover; and reports having issued instructions to staff in regard thereto, such instructions to remain confidential in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Act.

(City Council on December 14, 15 and 16, 1999, considered the aforementioned confidential joint report dated November 26, 1999 embodied in the communication (November 30, 1999) from the City Clerk, such joint report to remain confidential in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Act, save and except the following Option B embodied therein:

Taking reduced sulphur content into consideration where it is a significant factor as well as cost and meeting specifications, the award of this requirement should be made to Shell Canada Products Incorporated and Sunoco Incorporated, for the supply and delivery of the following fuels:
