Providing a set of minutes of the 2001 Operating Budget Subgroup meeting of the Toronto Cycling Committee held on September 18, 2000; and recommending that:

- (1) that Urban Development Services be requested to include the following monies in their 2001 Operating Budget submission and to report back to the Toronto Cycling Committee meeting at their October 10, 2000 meeting as to the status of the cycling program funding for next year:
 - (a) that staff levels be maintained through 2001 at the same level as 2000;
 - (b) that the base budget for cycling programs be maintained at \$108,000 for the year 2001; and
 - (c) that an additional \$150,000.00 be included in 2001 to fund the Road and Trail Safety Ambassador program; and
- (2) that the Education and Safety Sub-Committee, the Communications and Promotions Sub-Committee and the Network Planning and Facilities Sub-Committee discuss their recommended priorities for 2001 cycling programs so that Urban Development Services' staff can take these into consideration for the 2001 cycling program.
