

## **Naming of Public Lane Located East of Augusta Avenue, Extending Northerly from Baldwin Street - Littlehayes Lane (Downtown)**

**The Toronto Community Council recommends the adoption of the following report (August 25, 2000) from the City Surveyor, Works and Emergency Services:**

### Purpose:

This report recommends that the public lane located east of Augusta Avenue, extending northerly from Baldwin Street, be named "Littlehayes Lane".

### Financial Implications and Impact Statement:

There are no financial implications resulting from the implementation of this report.

### Recommendations:

It is recommended that:

- (1) the public lane located east of Augusta Avenue, extending northerly from Baldwin Street, illustrated on Attachment No. 1, be named "Littlehayes Lane"; and
- (2) the appropriate City Officials be authorized and directed to take the necessary action to give effect thereto.

### Background:

A request has been received from Kirk Cheney, a resident at 200A Baldwin Avenue, to name the public lane illustrated on Attachment No. 1. Naming the lane will better identify Mr. Cheney's residence which fronts thereon.

The lane is being named after Major E. B. Littlehayes, an aide to Governor Simcoe, who owned land in the vicinity of the lane. Further information on Major Littlehayes is outlined in Attachment No. 2.

### Comments:

The proposed name has been circulated for comment, and has the support of Councillor Olivia Chow, Toronto Fire Services, Toronto Police Service and Heritage Toronto.

### Conclusions:

The proposed name "Littlehayes Lane" is consistent with the City of Toronto Street Naming Policy approved by City Council at its meeting held on August 1, 2, 3 and 4, 2000 (Clause 9, Report 15 of the Works Committee).
