1.12 TORONTO PUBLIC LIBRARY - 2001 CAPITAL PROGRAM

Recommending that:

(1) the 2001 to 2005 recommended capital program of Toronto Public Library consisting of 30 new projects with a total project cost of \$102.1 million with cash flow commitments of \$5.7 million in 2001, with commitments of \$14.9 million in 2002, \$18.1 million in 2003, \$17.5 million in 2004 and \$20.6 million in 2005 as outlined in Appendix "B", be approved;

- (2) new debt service costs as outlined in Appendix "A", totalling \$11.05 million resulting from the approval of 2001 to 2005 recommended capital program with revised impacts of \$0.18 million in 2001, \$1.06 million in 2002, \$2.03 million in 2003, \$2.27 million in 2004 and \$2.41 million in 2005 and \$3.1 million in 2006 be approved for inclusion in the 2001 and future operating budgets;
- (3) new operating budget costs, as outlined in Appendix "A", totalling \$0.189 million by 2005 resulting from the approval of the 2001 to 2005 recommended capital program with incremental operating budget impacts of \$0.02 million in 2002, \$0 in 2003, \$0.097 million in 2004 and \$0.072 million in 2005, be approved for inclusion in the 2001 and future operating budgets;
- (4) for the purpose of establishing a spending control, the recommended 2001 to 2005 capital program of Toronto Public Library, with a total cash flow of \$88.4 million; \$76.8 million for new projects and \$11.6 million for previously approved projects, as outlined in Appendix "D", be approved; and
- (5) that four previously approved projects of 1998 and 1999 capital program, as outlined in Appendix "E", be closed.
