CONFIRMATION OF MINUTES – May 13, 2002 [Sent to Members by electronic mail]

1. PEER NUTRITION PROGRAM.

Medical Officer of Health (May 23, 2002)

Advising the Board of Health on some of the successes and challenges of the Peer Nutrition Program in the first two years of operation; advising that there are no financial implications resulting from the adoption of this report; and **recommending** that:

- (1) the Board of Health forward this report to the Community Services Committee and the Children and Youth Action Committee for information; and
- (2) the appropriate City officials be authorized and directed to take the necessary action to give effect thereto.

2. WEST NILE VIRUS PLAN FOR 2002.

Medical Officer of Health (May 28, 2002)

Outlining the West Nile Virus Plan to be implemented by the City of Toronto for 2002; advising of financial implications; and **recommending** that:

- (1) the Board of Health forward this report to the Works Committee and the Economic Development and Parks Committee for their information; and
- (2) the appropriate City officials be authorized to take the necessary action to give effect thereto.
