13. PEDESTRIAN MESSENGERS.

Communication addressed to the Works Committee from the City Clerk, Toronto Pedestrian Committee (February 11, 2003)

Advising that the Toronto Pedestrian Committee, at their meeting held on January 29, 2003, approved the following recommendation:

(1) set an example by advocating the use of pedestrian messengers whenever possible, if any small packages, are to be delivered in the City of Toronto (especially downtown), that could be done by foot, bicycle or public transit be transported in such a specifically apropos manner;

- request the Provincial and Federal Government follow the same sustainably responsible delivery practices as well as the private sector, when they are conducting their business within the confines of our fair City; and
