1. Appointments of Members of Council to the Association of Municipalities of Ontario

Communication (May 27, 2004) from the Secretary-Treasurer and the Chief Returning Officer, Association of Municipalities of Ontario (AMO), requesting nominations to the 2004-2005 AMO Board of Directors, by Friday July 23, 2004 and listing the positions.

It is recommended that:

- (3) the appropriate City officials be authorized and directed to take the necessary action to give effect thereto.
