Clause embodied in Report No. 1 of the Economic Development and Parks Committee, as adopted by the Council of the City of Toronto at its meeting held on January 27, 28 and 29, 2004.

Business Improvement Areas 2003 to 2006 Board of Management Nominees (All Wards)

(City Council on January 27, 28 and 29, 2004, amended this Clause by adding the following:

"It is further recommended that the Commissioner of Economic Development, Culture and Tourism, be requested to submit a report to the Economic Development and Parks Committee on amendments to the City of Toronto Municipal Code, Chapter 19, 'Business Improvement Areas', to reduce the required number of Councillors on the Board of Management of the Bloor By The Park Business Improvement Area, to provide for the withdrawal of Councillor Bill Saundercook from the Board.")

The Economic Development and Parks Committee recommends the adoption of the following report (December 10, 2003) from the Commissioner of Economic Development, Culture and Tourism:

Purpose:

To recommend appointments to the Boards of Management of 42 Business Improvement Areas and to make necessary amendments to the City of Toronto Municipal Code, Chapter 19, "Business Improvement Areas".

Financial Implications and Impact Statement:

There are no financial implications resulting from the adoption of this report.

Recommendations:

It is recommended that:

- (1) Council appoint the nominees listed in Attachment No. 1 to this report to the Boards of Management for 42 Business Improvement Areas (BIAs) for the 2003 to 2006 term;
- (2) the City BIA Office be directed to organize and conduct an Annual General Meeting for the Upper Village (York) and Upper Village (Toronto) BIAs in January for the sole purpose of electing members to their respective Boards of Management;

- (3) Council approve the BIA name changes set out below:
 - St. Lawrence Neighbourhood BIA to become "St. Lawrence Market Neighbourhood" BIA; and
 - St. Clair-Bathurst BIA to become "Wychwood Heights" BIA;
- (4) Council amend the City of Toronto Municipal Code, Chapter 19, "Business Improvement Areas", to alter the number of members on the Boards of Management, and the number of members required for quorum for various BIAs as set out in Attachment No. 2;
- (5) Council request the St. Lawrence Centre, St. Lawrence Market, and Hummingbird Centre to each appoint a representative to the Board of Management for the St. Lawrence Market Neighbourhood BIA;
- (6) leave be granted for the introduction of the necessary bills in Council to give effect thereto; and
- (7) the appropriate City officials be authorized and directed to take the necessary action to give effect thereto.

Background:

Section 204 of the <u>Municipal Act</u> requires that Council appoint members to the Boards of Management of each BIA for a term expiring at the end of the term of the Council making the appointments.

Persons qualified to sit on a Board of Management include commercial property owners, commercial and industrial tenants within the BIA, or other persons who may be nominated by an owner or tenant. Each of the nominees set out in Attachment No. 1 meets the requirements for membership set out in Section 204 of the <u>Municipal Act</u>.

Chapter 19 of the Municipal Code sets out the number of members to sit on each Board and the number of members required for Quorum.

Comments:

Forty-two BIAs held Annual General Meetings (AGM) to elect members to their Boards of Management for the 2003-2006 term of Council. A number of BIAs also voted to alter the number of members to sit on their Board and the number of members required for quorum. City staff attended each AGM to ensure elections were held in accordance with the Municipal Act and Municipal Code.

Council members are appointed to the Board of Management of each BIA through the Striking Committee. At its meeting of December 4, 2003, City Council appointed Councillors to the Boards of Management of the BIAs and in some cases reduced the number of Councillors to sit on the Boards of Management.

At the Annual General Meeting of the St. Lawrence Neighbourhood BIA, the members voted to have a representative of the St. Lawrence Centre, Hummingbird Centre and St. Lawrence Market sit on the Board. It was felt that these boards of the City would provide useful input into the operating and capital planning of the BIA. As these boards of the City have no mandate to appoint representatives to the BIA Board of Management, it is recommended that Council request each to appoint a representative.

Two BIAs also voted to change the name of their respective BIAs. Accordingly, it is recommended that the St. Lawrence Neighbourhood BIA be renamed the "St. Lawrence Market Neighbourhood" BIA and the St. Clair Bathurst BIA be renamed the "Wychwood Heights" BIA.

Attachment No. 1 of this report sets out the list of Board members for each BIA. Attachment No. 2 sets out technical amendments to Schedule "A", Chapter 19 of the Municipal Code respecting the number of members of each Board, the number of members required for quorum and the BIA name changes noted above.

Only three BIAs failed to hold the required Annual General Meeting and appoint a Board of Management. One of these BIAs (Mount Dennis) has been inactive for some time and the BIA Office will discuss the viability of this BIA with the local Councillor and local businesses. Upper Village (York) and Upper Village (Toronto) remain active but failed to conduct the required Annual General Meeting despite repeated requests from the City's BIA Office to do so. In fact, neither has conducted an AGM since 2000. In order to remedy this situation it is recommended that Council direct the BIA Office to organize and conduct an Annual General Meeting for the Upper Village (York) and Upper Village (Toronto) BIAs in January 2004 for the purpose of electing members to their respective Boards of Management. Following this, the new Boards can arrange meetings to discuss and approve their 2004 budgets.

Conclusions:

In accordance with the <u>Municipal Act</u> and Municipal Code, Council must appoint members to the Boards of Management of each BIA. The names put forward in this report were duly nominated at the Annual General Meeting of their respective BIAs. Therefore, it is recommended that Council appoint the nominees to the Boards of Management as set out in Attachment No. 1. Several BIAs also voted to modify the number of Board Members and the number of members required for quorum which must also be approved by Council. These changes are set out in Attachment No. 2.
