Confirmation of Minutes

On motion by Don Altman, the minutes of the meeting of the Bid Committee held on September 28, 2005, were confirmed.

40.1 Plant Services Prime Technical Consultant, RFP 9117-05-7190 - (Ward 32 - Beaches-East York, Ward 44 - Scarborough East and Ward 5 - Etobicoke Lakeshore)

The Bid Committee considered a report (September 26, 2005) from the Executive Director of Technical Services and the Acting Director of Purchasing and Materials Management, advising on the results of Request for Proposal (RFP) 9117-05-7190, for the provision of technical consultant services for the Plant Services Control Systems for the Ashbridges Bay (TAB), Highland Creek (THC) and Humber (THR) Treatment

Plants, and requesting authority to award an engineering consulting services agreement with the highest scoring proponent.

Recommendation:

It is recommended that the firm of AWS Engineers and Planners Corp., being the highest scoring proponent meeting the requirements, be retained to provide technical consultant services for the Plant Services Control Systems for the Ashbridges Bay (TAB), Highland Creek (THC) and Humber (THR) Treatment Plants for an estimated cost not to exceed \$870,653.30, including disbursements, and GST, and including a contingency allowance of \$100,000.00 inclusive of GST, for additional services, if necessary and authorized by the Executive Director of Technical Services.

40.2 Request for Quotation 3907-05-5202 - Supply of all Labour, Equipment and Materials Necessary for the Construction and Renovation Work at Ambulance Station 43 - 126 Pape Avenue (Ward 30 - Toronto-Danforth)

The Bid Committee considered a report (September 22, 2005) from the Acting Director of Purchasing and Materials Management, advising on the results of the Request for Quotation for the supply of all labour, equipment and materials necessary for the Construction and Renovation Work at Ambulance Station 43 at 126 Pape Avenue, Toronto in accordance with specifications, as required by the Design and Asset Preservation Unit, Facilities and Real Estate Division, and requesting authority to award a contract to the recommended bidder.

Recommendation:

It is recommended that the Quotation for the supply of all labour, equipment and materials necessary for the Construction and Renovation Work at Ambulance Station 43, at 126 Pape Avenue, Toronto be awarded to B.W.K Construction Company Limited, in the amount of \$556,935.00 including all taxes and charges, being the lowest bid received.

The Bid Committee considered a report (October 4, 2005) from the Executive Director, Technical Services, and the Manager of Purchasing and Materials Management, Goods and Services, advising on the results of the Tender issued for Road Construction, Road Resurfacing and Watermain Replacement on Erskine Avenue and Elvina Gardens, in North York District, in accordance with specifications as required by Technical Services, and requesting authority to award a contract to the recommended bidder.

Recommendation:

It is recommended that Contract 05ND-17RD, Tender Call 177-2005, for Road Construction, Road Resurfacing and Watermain Replacement on Erskine Avenue and Elvina Gardens in North York District, be awarded to Gazzola Paving Limited, in the amount of \$1,263,879.38 including all taxes and charges, being the lowest bid received.

On motion by Don Altman, the Bid Committee adopted the staff recommendation in the Recommendation Section of the report.

The Bid Committee considered a report (October 4, 2005) from the General Manager of Transportation Services and the Manager of Purchasing and Materials Management, Goods and Services, advising on the results of the Tender Call issued for the Resurfacing and Maintenance Repairs to various types of pavements and sidewalks in the Toronto and East York District, in accordance with specifications as required by Transportation Services, and requesting authority to award a contract to the recommended bidder.

Recommendation:

It is recommended that Contract 05TD-110TR, Tender Call 213-2005, for Resurfacing and Maintenance Repairs to various types of pavements and sidewalks in the Toronto and East York District, be awarded to Pave-Tar Construction Ltd., in the amount of \$644,444.43, including all taxes and charges, being the lowest bid received.

On motion by Tobias Novogrodsky, the Bid Committee adopted the staff recommendation in the Recommendation Section of the report.

The Bid Committee considered a report (October 4, 2005) from the Executive Director of Technical Services and the Manager of Purchasing and Materials Management, Goods and Services, advising on the results of the Tender issued for the Rehabilitation and Reconstruction of Advance Road from Shawbridge Avenue to Islington Avenue, Olivewood Road from Judge Road to Shawbridge Avenue, Six Point Road from Judge Road to Shawbridge Avenue, Judge Road from Bering Avenue to Six Point Road and Shawbridge Avenue from Olivewood Road to Advance Road, in accordance with specifications as required by Technical Services, and requesting authority to award a contract to the recommended bidder.

Recommendation:

It is recommended that Contract 05WD-18RD, Tender Call 194-2005, for the Rehabilitation and Reconstruction of Advance Road from Shawbridge Avenue to Islington Avenue, Olivewood Road from Judge Road to Shawbridge Avenue, Six Point Road from Judge Road to Shawbridge Avenue, Judge Road from Bering Avenue to Six Point Road and Shawbridge Avenue from Olivewood Road to Advance Road be awarded to Comer Group Limited, in the amount of \$3,584,844.23, including all taxes and charges, being the lowest bid received.

with specifications, as required by Parks, Forestry and Recreation, and requesting authority to award a contract to the recommended bidder.

Recommendation:

It is recommended that the Quotation for the Facility Rehabilitations on Toronto Island, (Ward 28 - Toronto Centre-Rosedale), be awarded to Alpeza General Contracting Inc., in the amount of \$694,430.00 including all taxes and charges, being the lowest bid received.

40.7 Contract 05FS-38S, Tender Call 226-2005 - Finch Avenue West Culvert Replacement at Black Creek, West of Keele Street (Ward 8 - York West)

Recommendation:

It is recommended that Contract 05FS-38S, Tender Call 226-2005, for the Finch Avenue West Culvert Replacement at Black Creek, West of Keele Street, be awarded to St. Lawrence Cement Inc., c.o.b. as Dufferin Construction Company, in the total amount of \$2,417,996.70 including all taxes and charges, being the lowest bid received.
