**Honourary Street Name Sign -  
"Gilda Radner Way"  
(Ward 28 - Toronto Centre-Rosedale)**

**The Toronto and East York Community Council recommends that City Council authorize the General Manager of Transportation to post special honorary name signs, to read "Gilda Radner Way" on Lombard Street.**

**The Toronto and East York Community Council submits the communication (undated) from Councillor McConnell:**

We have received a request, on behalf of Gilda's Club greater Toronto, a non-profit support organization for men, women, teens and children touched by cancer, that in celebration of their 5<sup>th</sup> Anniversary on October 17, 2006, an honorary street sign be provided on Lombard Street in Ward 28.

Gilda's Club is located at 110 Lombard Street and is named in honour of the late comedienne Gilda Radner. Prior to her death in 1989, Gilda's wish was that no one ever face cancer alone. The Lombard Street facility is one of 17 in cities across North America that fulfill this wish.

This tribute is also particularly fitting because the 110 Lombard Street location where Gilda's Club is located was where Ms. Radner got her career started when the building was the original Second city.

**Recommendation:**

That special honorary street name signs, to read "Gilda Radner Way" be posted on Lombard Street.
