On motion by Mae Maracle, the minutes of the meeting of the Bid Committee held on May 24, 2006, were confirmed.

22.1 Contract 06EY-104TM, Tender Call 111-2006 - Repairs to Roads and Sidewalks in Etobicoke York District (Wards 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 11, 12, 13 and 17)

The Bid Committee considered a report (May 16, 2006) from the General Manager of Transportation Services and the Manager of Goods and Services, Purchasing and Materials Management, advising on the results of the Tender Call 111-2006, issued for Repairs to Roads and Sidewalks in Etobicoke York District, in accordance with specifications as required by Transportation Services, and requesting authority to award a contract to the recommended bidder.

Recommendation:

It is recommended that authority be granted to award Contract 06EY-104TM Tender Call 111-2006, to Paddock Development Limited, in the amount of \$2,046,553.69

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including all applicable taxes and charges for the Repairs to Roads and Sidewalks in Etobicoke York District.

The Bid Committee considered a report (May 23, 2006) from the Executive Director of Technical Services and the Acting Director of Purchasing and Materials Management, advising on the results of the Tender issued for Watermain Replacement on Genthorn Avenue, Berry Creek Drive, Crowland Drive, Elmhurst Drive, Fordwich Crescent, Moncreiff Drive, Tayrow Road, Hinton Road and Wansey Road, in accordance with specifications as required by Technical Services, and requesting the authority to award a contract to the recommended bidder.

Recommendation:

- (3) authority be granted to award a contract to Amaida Construction Limited, for the period June 1, 2006 to May 31, 2007, in the total amount of \$221,385.84 including all applicable taxes and charges for the supply of all labour, equipment and materials necessary for minor building repairs for various locations throughout the City of Toronto, for the Facilities & Real Estate Division, with

Weaver Flooring Ltd., from the date of award to May 24, 2007, in the total amount of \$237,547.80 including all applicable taxes and charges for the supply and installation of various flooring materials as and when required to various locations throughout the City of Toronto, for the Facilities and Real Estate Division, with the option to renew at the sole discretion of the Executive Director of Facilities and Real Estate for the period from May 25, 2007 to May 24, 2008, in the total amount of \$237,547.80 including all applicable taxes and charges, and with a second option to renew at the sole discretion of the Executive Director of Facilities and Real Estate, for the period from May 25, 2008 to May 24, 2009, in the total amount of \$237,547.80 including all applicable taxes and charges provided that the supply and

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installation of various flooring materials as and when required to various locations throughout the City of Toronto, for the Facilities and Real Estate Division, were performed at a satisfactory level and subject to budget approval, the Executive Director of Facilities and Real Estate to instruct the Chief Purchasing Official to process the necessary contract renewals under the same terms and conditions; and

(2) authority be granted to award a contract to Cooksville Interior (Miss) Ltd., from the date of award to May 24, 2007, in the total amount of \$243,224.10 including all applicable taxes and charges for the supply and installation of various flooring materials as and when required to various locations throughout the City of Toronto, for the Facilities and Real Estate Division, with the option to renew at the sole discretion of the Executive Director of Facilities and Real Estate, for the period from May 25, 2007 to May 24, 2008, in the total amount of \$247,500.45 including all applicable taxes and charges, and with a second option to renew at the sole discretion of the Executive Director of Facilities and Real Estate for the period from May 25, 2008 to May 24, 2009 in the total amount of \$257,430.15 provided that the supply and installation of various flooring materials as and when required to various locations throughout the City of Toronto, for the Facilities and Real Estate Division, were performed at a satisfactory level and subject to budget approval, the Executive Director of Facilities and Real Estate, to instruct the Chief Purchasing Official to process the necessary contract renewals under the same terms and conditions.

22.5 Authority to Award Request for Proposal (RFP) 2104-06-3034 - For a Telecommunications Expense Management System

The Bid Committee considered a report (May 23, 2006) from the Acting Director of Purchasing and Materials Management, advising on the results of the Request for Proposal 2104-06-3034, for a Telecommunications Expense Management System (TEMS) and requesting authority to award a contract to the Preferred Proponent and to negotiate terms for the initial purchase, implementation and maintenance and support costs, with an option favouring the City of Toronto to renew the support on an annual basis for the four years following the initial one year warranty.

Recommendation:

It is recommended that authority be granted to award a contract to Ace*Comm Corporation, in the amount of \$659,010.86, including all applicable taxes and charges, for the provision of a Telecommunication Expense Management System.
