Confirmation of Minutes

On motion by Don Altman, the minutes of the meeting of the Bid Committee held on August 2, 2006, were confirmed.

**32.1 Contract 06EY-26RD, Tender Call 147-2006 - Pavement Reconstruction and Traffic Calming - Local Streets (Ward 11 - York South-Weston, Ward 15 - Eglinton-Lawrence and Ward 17 - Davenport)**

The Bid Committee considered a report (August 2, 2006) from the Executive Director of Technical Services and the Director of Purchasing and Materials Management, advising on the results of the tender issued for the Pavement Reconstruction and Traffic Calming - Local Streets, in accordance with specifications as required by Technical Services, and requesting authority to award a contract to the recommended bidder.

Recommendation:

It is recommended that authority be granted to award Contract 06EY-26RD, Tender Call 147-2006, to Il Duca Contracting Inc., in the amount of \$784,305.46, including all taxes and charges, for the Pavement Reconstruction and Traffic Calming - Local Streets, having submitted the lowest acceptable bid meeting specifications.

On motion by Wayne Scott the Bid Committee adopted the staff recommendation in the Recommendation Section of the report.

**32.2 Contract 06EY-22RD, Tender Call 149-2006 - Rehabilitation of Princess Anne Manor Area Streets with Cold-in-Place Asphalt Pavement Recycling (Ward 4 - Etobicoke Centre)**

The Bid Committee considered a report (July 31, 2006) from the Executive Director of Technical Services and the Director of Purchasing and Materials Management, advising on the results of the tender issued for the Rehabilitation of Princess Anne Manor Area Streets with Cold-in-Place Asphalt Pavement Recycling, in accordance with specifications as required by Technical Services, and requesting authority to award a contract to the recommended bidder.

Recommendation:

It is recommended that authority be granted to award Contract 06EY-22RD, Tender Call 149-2006, for the Rehabilitation of Princess Anne Manor Area Streets with Cold-in-Place Asphalt Pavement Recycling to Gazzola Paving Limited, in the amount of \$1,125,024.86, including all taxes and charges, having submitted the lowest bid meeting specifications.

On motion by Wayne Scott the Bid Committee adopted the staff recommendation in the Recommendation Section of the report.

**31.3 Contract 06EY-05RD, Tender Call 156-2006 - Reconstruction of Arnold Street including Sidewalk and Storm Sewer; Road Widening of Attwell Drive (Ward 6 - Etobicoke Lakeshore and Ward 2 - Etobicoke North)**

The Bid Committee considered a report (July 28, 2006) from the Executive Director of Technical Services and the Director of Purchasing and Materials Management, advising on the results of the Tender issued for the Reconstruction of Arnold Street including Sidewalk and Storm Sewer, and the Road Widening of Attwell Drive, in accordance with specifications as required by Technical Services, and requesting authority to award a contract to the recommended bidder.

Recommendation:

It is recommended that authority be granted to award Contract 06EY-05RD, Tender Call 156-2006, to Gazzola Paving Limited, in the amount of \$872,615.49, including all taxes and charges, for the Reconstruction of Arnold Street including Sidewalk and Storm Sewer, and the Road Widening of Attwell Drive, having submitted the lowest bid meeting specifications.

On motion by Wayne Scott the Bid Committee adopted the staff recommendation in the Recommendation Section of the report.

**32.4 Contract 06SC-10RD, Tender Call 159-2006 - Warden Avenue - Major Road Resurfacing and Upton Road - Local Road Resurfacing, Scarborough District (Ward 35 - Scarborough Southwest)**

The Bid Committee considered a report (July 31, 2006) from the Executive Director of Technical Services and the Director of Purchasing and Materials Management, advising on the results of the Tender issued for the Warden Avenue - Major Road Resurfacing and Upton Road - Local Road Resurfacing, Scarborough District, in accordance with specifications as required by Technical Services, and requesting authority to award a contract to the recommended bidder.

Recommendation:

It is recommended that authority be granted to award Contract 06SC-10RD, Tender Call 159-2006, for the Warden Avenue - Major Road Resurfacing and Upton Road - Local Road Resurfacing, Scarborough District, to Furfari Paving Co. Ltd., in the amount of \$2,603,183.67, including all taxes and charges, having submitted the lowest bid meeting specifications.

On motion by Don Altman the Bid Committee adopted the staff recommendation in the Recommendation Section of the report.

**32.5 Contract 06EY-28RD, Tender Call 167-2006 - Valley Crescent Watermain, Sewers and Pavement; Hyde Avenue Watermain (Ward 12 - York South-Weston)**

The Bid Committee considered a report (July 28, 2006) from the Executive Director of Technical Services and the Director of Purchasing and Materials Management, advising on the results of the tender Call 167-2006 issued for the Reconstruction of Valley Crescent including Watermain, Sewers and Pavement, and the Construction of Watermain on Hyde Avenue, in accordance with specifications as required by Technical Services, and requesting authority to award a contract to the recommended bidder.

Recommendation:

It is recommended that authority be granted to award Contract 06EY-28RD, Tender Call 167-2006, for the Reconstruction of Valley Crescent including Watermain, Sewers and Pavement, and the Construction of Watermain on Hyde Avenue, to F.D.M. Contracting Co. Ltd., in the amount of \$1,470,434.44, including all taxes and charges, having submitted the lowest bid meeting specifications.

On motion by Wayne Scott the Bid Committee adopted the staff recommendation in the Recommendation Section of the report.
