Confirmation of Minutes

On motion by Laurie McQueen, the minutes of the meeting of the Bid Committee held on August 30, 2006, were confirmed.

36.1 Request for Proposals (RFP) 9118-05-7412 - Provision of Professional Services for Ashbridges Bay Treatment Plant Phase 1 Detailed Landscape Plan (Ward 32, Beaches-East York)

The Bid Committee considered a report (August 23, 2006) from the Executive Director of Technical Services and the Director of Purchasing and Materials Management, advising on the results of the Request for Proposals (RFP) No. 9118-05-7412 for the provision of professional services for the Ashbridges Bay Treatment Plant (ABTP) Phase 1 Detailed Landscape Plan, and requesting authority to award a contract to the recommended proponent.

Recommendations:

It is recommended that authority be granted to award a contract in the amount \$2,144,796.75, including provisional items, disbursements, contingencies, and all applicable taxes be awarded to ENVision - The Hough Group, having submitted the highest scoring submission, for the provision of professional services for the Ashbridges Bay Treatment Plant Phase 1 Detailed Landscape Plan as follows:

- (a) for the preliminary and detailed design, an amount not to exceed \$1,219,794.76 including provisional items, disbursements and GST, and including a contingency allowance of \$110,890.44 including GST for additional services, if necessary and authorized by the Executive Director, Technical Services;
- (b) for services during construction including general office administration and site supervision services, an amount not to exceed \$888,482.88, including provisional items, construction disbursements and GST for a construction period up to 104 weeks. This amount also includes a contingency allowance of \$84,906.00, including disbursements and GST for additional services beyond the construction period of 104 weeks at a rate not to exceed \$5,340.00 per week, if necessary and authorized by the Executive Director, Technical Services; and
- (c) for the post-construction services, an amount not to exceed \$36,519.12, including disbursements and GST, and including a contingency allowance of \$3,319.92, including GST for additional services, if necessary and authorized by the Executive Director, Technical Services.

On motion by Don Altman, the Bid Committee adopted the staff recommendations in the Recommendations Section of the report.

36.2 Contract 06SC-22RD, Tender Call 173-2006 - Local Road Reconstruction on Ellie Drive and Golfhaven Drive, Scarborough District (Ward 43, Scarborough East)

The Bid Committee considered a report (August 22, 2006) from the Executive Director of Technical Services and the Director of Purchasing and Materials Management, advising on the results of the Tender issued for Local Road Reconstruction on Ellie Drive and Golfhaven Drive, Scarborough District, in accordance with specifications as required by Technical Services, and requesting the authority to award a contract to the recommended bidder.

Recommendation:

It is recommended that authority be granted to award Contract 06SC-22RD, Tender Call 173-2006, for the Local Road Reconstruction on Ellie Drive and Golfhaven Drive, Scarborough District, to Grascan Construction Ltd., in the amount of \$1,370,580.00, including all taxes and charges, having submitted the lowest bid.

36.3 Contract 06TE-55RD, Tender Call 192-2006 - Reconstruction of Pavement and Partial Reconstruction of Sidewalk and Curb on Parliament Street from 36 m North of Lake Shore Boulevard East to King Street East (Ward 28, Toronto Centre-Rosedale)

The Bid Committee considered a report (August 25, 2006) from the Executive Director of Technical Services and the Director of Purchasing and Materials Management, advising on the results of the Tender issued for Reconstruction of Pavement and Partial Reconstruction of Sidewalk and Curb on Parliament Street from 36 m North of Lake Shore Boulevard East to King Street East, in accordance with specifications as required by Technical Services, and requesting authority to award a contract to the recommended bidder.

Recommendation:

It is recommended that authority be granted to award Contract 06TE-55RD, Tender 192-2006, for Reconstruction of Pavement and Partial Reconstruction of Sidewalk and Curb on Parliament Street from 36 m North of Lake Shore Boulevard East to King Street East, to CRCE Construction Ltd., in the amount of \$1,285,337.45, including all applicable taxes and charges, having submitted the lowest bid.

36.4 Contract 06TE-201RD, Tender Call 185-2006 - Reconstruction of Laneways at Various Locations in the Toronto and East York District (Ward 18, Davenport, Ward 19, Trinity-Spadina and Ward 21, St. Paul's)

The Bid Committee considered a report (August 24, 2006) from the Executive Director of Technical Services and the Director of Purchasing and Materials Management, advising on the results of the Tender issued for Reconstruction of Laneways at Various Locations in the Toronto and East York District, in accordance with specifications as required by Technical Services, and requesting authority to award a contract to the recommended bidder.
