1. RFP 9155-06-7233 – Contract Award for Yard Consolidation Study – West District Segment (Wards 1-7, 11-13, 15, 17)

#### Action taken by the Committee:

The Bid Committee adopted the staff recommendation in the Recommendation Section of the report (March 16, 2007) from the Director, Purchasing and Materials Management.

- (2) the Quotation submitted by the lowest acceptable bidder meeting specifications, D. Crupi & Sons Limited, be awarded a contract for:
  - (a) the East District for both Winter Seasons from December 1, 2006 to April 15, 2007 and December 1, 2007 to April 15, 2008, for both Summer Seasons from April 16, 2007 to November 30, 2007 and from April 16, 2008 to November 30, 2008;

in the total amount of \$1,016,163.36 net of G.S.T. for the supply of Hot Mix Asphalt and Performance Grade Asphalt Cement; and

(3) Recommendations 1 and 2 above be contingent on Council approval of the appropriate Operating Budgets for Transportation Services and Toronto Water; and Solid Waste Management.
