Confirmation of Minutes

On motion by Don Altman, the minutes of the meeting of the Bid Committee held on July 11, 2007, were confirmed.

27.1 Contract 07EY-113TM, Tender Call 140-2007 Repairs to Roads and Sidewalks (Wards 4, 5, 6, 7, 11, 12, 13 and 17 - Etobicoke York District)

The Bid Committee considered a report (July 3, 2007) from the General Manager, Transportation Services and the Director, Purchasing and Materials Management, advising on the results of Tender Call 140-2007 issued for Repairs to Roads and Sidewalks, Wards 4, 5, 6, 7, 11, 12, 13 and 17 – Etobicoke York District, in accordance with specifications as required by Transportation Services, and requesting authority to award a contract to the recommended bidder.

Recommendation:

The General Manager of Transportation Services and the Director of Purchasing and Materials Management recommend that authority be granted to award Contract 07EY-113TM, Tender Call 140-2007, for Repairs to Roads and Sidewalks, Wards 4, 5, 6,

7, 11, 12, 13 and 17 Etobicoke York District, to Pave-Tar Construction Ltd., in the amount of \$1,858,207.25, net of GST, having submitted the lowest bid.

On motion by Laurie McQueen, the Bid Committee adopted the staff recommendation in the Recommendation Section of the report (July 3, 2007) from the General Manager, Transportation Services and the Director, Purchasing and Materials Management.

27.2 Contract 07TE-01RD, Tender Call 156-2007 Reconstruction of TTC Track Allowance, Adjacent Pavement and Sidewalk on Dundas Street East from Victoria Street to River Street (Wards 27 and 28 – Toronto Centre – Rosedale)

The Bid Committee considered a report (June 15, 2007) from the Executive Director, Technical Services and the Director, Purchasing and Materials Management, advising on the results of Tender Call 156-2007 issued for Reconstruction of TTC Track Allowance, Adjacent Pavement and Sidewalk on Dundas Street East from Victoria Street to River Street, in accordance with specifications as required by Technical Services and requesting authority to award a contract to the recommended bidder.

Recommendation:

The Executive Director of Technical Services and the Director of Purchasing and Materials Management recommend that authority be granted to award Contract 07TE-01RD, Tender Call 156-2007 to Sanscon Construction Ltd. in the amount of \$3,598,850.00, net of GST, for Reconstruction of TTC Track Allowance, Adjacent Pavement and Sidewalk on Dundas Street East from Victoria Street to River Street having submitted the lowest bid.

27.3 Provision of Copper-Silver Ionization System for Homes for the Aged RFQ #4203-07-0094 (All Wards – Homes for the Aged Services all Toronto Areas)

The Bid Committee considered a report (July 5, 2007) from the General Manager, Homes for the Aged and the Director, Purchasing and Materials Management, advising on the results of the Request for Quotation 4203-07-0094 issued for the supply and delivery of all labour, equipment, materials necessary to install and maintain a copper-silver ionization system on the domestic hot water loops at various locations in accordance with the specifications as required by the Homes for the Aged Division, and requesting authority to award a contract to the recommended bidder.

Recommendation:

The General Manager of Homes for the Aged Division and the Director of Purchasing and Materials Management recommend that authority be granted to award a contract to Liquitech Inc., being the lowest bidder, to supply, deliver, install and maintain copper-silver ionization systems for a five year period starting from the date of award to December 31, 2012 for a total amount of \$613,344.00 net of G.S.T.

The Bid Committee considered a report (July 5, 2007) from the General Manager, Transportation Services and the Director, Purchasing and Materials Management, advising on the results of Tender Call 177-2007 issued for Supply, Replace and Adjust Frames, Grates and Covers for Maintenance Holes, Valve Chambers and Catch Basins, Etobicoke York District, in accordance with specifications as required by Transportation Services, and requesting authority to award a contract to the recommended bidder.

Recommendation:

The General Manager of Transportation Services and the Director of Purchasing and Materials Management recommend that authority be granted to award Contract 07EY-110TM, Tender Call 177-2007, for Supply, Replace and Adjust Frames, Grates and Covers for Maintenance Holes, Valve Chambers and Catch Basins, to Gazzola Paving Ltd., in the amount of \$593,220.00, net of GST, having submitted the lowest bid meeting specification.

/or Existing Concrete Sidewalk and/or Curb at Various Wards in the Toronto & East York District, in accordance with specifications as required by Transportation Services and requesting authority to award a contract to the recommended bidder.

Recommendation:

The General Manager of Transportation Services Division and the Director of Purchasing and Materials Management recommend that authority be granted to award Contract 07TE-106TR, Tender Call 183-2007 to D. Martino Construction Limited, in the amount of \$941,037.25, net of GST, for the Construction of New and /or Existing Concrete Sidewalk and/or Curb at Various Wards in the Toronto & East York District, having submitted the lowest bid.

The Bid Committee considered a report (July 6, 2007) from the Executive Director, Technical Services and the Director, Purchasing and Materials Management, advising on the results of Tender Call 190-2007 issued for road reconstruction on Meadowbrook Road, Fraserwood Avenue, and Little Boulevard and watermain replacements on Meadowbrook Road, Fraserwood Avenue, Reddick Court and Chater Court, in North York District, in accordance with specifications as required by Technical Services and requesting authority to award a contract to the recommended bidder.

Recommendation:

The Executive Director of Technical Services and the Director of Purchasing and Materials Management recommend that authority be granted to award Contract 07NY-04RD, Tender Call 190-2007, for road reconstruction on Meadowbrook Road, Fraserwood Avenue, Little Boulevard and watermain replacements on Meadowbrook Road, Fraserwood Avenue, Reddick Court and Chater Court, to Sam Rabito Construction Ltd., in the amount of \$1,531,069.42 net of GST having submitted the lowest bid.

The Bid Committee considered a report (July 6, 2007) from the Director of Purchasing and Materials Management, advising on the results of Request for Quotation 3717-07-5064 for the supply of all labour, materials and equipment necessary for Phase 2 Landscape Redevelopment at Victoria Memorial Square in accordance with Bid Documents and requesting authority to award the contract to the recommended bidder.

Recommendation:

The Director of Purchasing and Materials Management recommends that authority be granted to award Request for Quotation 3717-07-5064 for the supply of all labour, materials and equipment necessary for Phase 2 Landscape Redevelopment at Victoria Memorial Square to Pine Valley Enterprises Inc. in the amount of \$574,216.00, net of GST being the lowest bid.

On motion by Miranda King, the Bid Committee adopted the staff recommendation in the Recommendation Section of the report (July 6, 2007) from the Director of Purchasing and Materials Management.
