 - b) Otis Canada Inc., in the amount of \$1,927,915.35 net of GST being the lowest bidder in the following Divisional locations: Shelter, Support and Housing: 291 Sherbourne St. Robertson House, Toronto Water: 9 Leslie Street Ashbridges Bay Treatment Plant, Facilities and Real Estate: 40 College Street Police Headquarters, 100 Queen Street West City Hall and 55 John Street Metro Hall.
