1. Contract Award - Request for Proposal 9119-08-7203, Energy and Water Efficiency Improvements in Ambulance Stations (Wards: All)

## Action taken by the Committee:

The Bid Committee adopted the staff recommendation in the Recommendation Section of the report (September 30, 2008) from the Acting Director of Purchasing and Materials Management.

Report (September 30, 2008) from the Acting Director of Purchasing and Materials Management, advising the Bid Committee on the results of the Request for Proposal (RFP) 9119-08-7203 for the Energy and Water Efficiency Improvements in Ambulance Stations and requesting the Bid Committee to authorize staff to enter into an energy services agreement with the recommended Proponent.
