1. **Contract Award - Tender Call 186-2008, Contract No. 08NY-120TM for the Removal, Replacement, and New Installation of Concrete Sidewalks, Bus Loading Platforms and Asphalt Walkways (Wards 8, 9, 10, 15, 16, 23, 24 25, 33 and 34, North York District)**

Action taken by the Committee:

The Bid Committee adopted the staff recommendation in the Recommendation Section of the report (October 9, 2008) from the Acting Director of Purchasing and Materials Management.

Report (October 9, 2008) from the Acting Director of Purchasing and Materials Management, advising on the results of Tender Call 186-2008, for the Removal, Replacement, and New Installation of Concrete Sidewalks, Bus Loading Platforms and Asphalt Walkways, North York District, in accordance with specifications as required by the Transportation Services Division and requesting authority to award a contract to the recommended bidder.

Recommendation:

The Acting Director of Purchasing and Materials Management recommends that:
