Items 1 to 5 are Pre-hearings**1. Shaarei Rose Switzer (Report No. 5771)**

Holder of Taxicab Owner's Licence No. V02-3099885, Plate No. 2910
Plate Removal: November 9, 2011.

The Tribunal approved the following pre-hearing agreement.

- (1) Shaarei Rose Switzer's taxicab owner's licence will be placed on probation for one (1) year to commence on the date that this recommendation is approved by the Toronto Licensing Tribunal;
- (2) during that one (1) year period, if there are any mechanical defects resulting in a plate removal, the report of November 21, 2011 regarding taxicab plate no. 2910, plate removal November 9, 2011, will be brought forward with respect to its liability and the appropriate penalty; and
