## TORONTO LICENSING TRIBUNAL: February 16, 2012

### Summary of Decisions

1. **Kumanatasan Ponnuthurai** (*Report No. 5653*)

Applicant for Renewal of Ambassador Taxicab Owner's Licence No. V02-3589041.

The Tribunal adjourned this matter to April 19, 2012 with Mr. Ponnuthurai's licence suspension to continue in the interim.

2. **Afshin Pezeshknejad** (*Report No. 5649*)

Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-3731430.

The Tribunal denied the renewal of Afshin Pezeshknejad's taxicab driver's licence No. D01-3731430.

(Mr. Pezeshknejad failed to attend today's hearing.)

3. **Akhtar Karim** (*Report No. 5674*)

Applicant for Renewal of Ambassador Taxicab Owner's Licence No. V02-3589617.

The Tribunal approved the following joint recommendation:

Akhtar Karim's Ambassador taxicab owner's licence No. V02-3589617 will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of two (2) years;
- (2) prior to each of the next two renewals of the licence, Mr. Karim must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record and criminal record check;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Mr. Karim incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Criminal Code*, or the *Highway Traffic Act*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has any concerns with any new charges or convictions under the *Highway Traffic Act*, the *Criminal Code* or the Toronto Municipal Code, those matters and report No. 5674 and any updating material may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

**4. Mohammad Hosseinioun** (*Report No. 5675*)

Applicant for Renewal of Ambassador Taxicab Owner's Licence No. V02-3588399.

The Tribunal approved the following joint recommendation:

Mohammad Hosseinioun's Ambassador taxicab owner's licence No. V02-3588399 will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years;
- (2) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Hosseinioun must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Mr. Hosseinioun incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Highway Traffic Act*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has any concerns with any new charges or convictions under the *Highway Traffic Act*, the *Criminal Code* or the Toronto Municipal Code, those matters and report No. 5675 and any updating material may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

**5. Asklepios Pharmaceutical Co. Ltd.** (*Report No. 5678*)

Applicant for Renewal of Retail Store (Food) Licence No. B50-3948652.

The Tribunal approved the following joint recommendation:

Asklepios Pharmaceutical Co. Ltd.'s retail store (food) licence No. B50-3948652 will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of one (1) year;
- (2) during the probationary period, if the Corporation incurs any new charges or convictions under the Toronto Municipal Code, it must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (3) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has any concerns with any new charges or convictions under the Toronto Municipal Code, those matters and report No. 5678 and any updating material may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

**6. P. Kenrick Homer** (*Report No. 5684*)

Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-0098424.

The Tribunal approved the following joint recommendation:

P. Kenrick Homer's taxicab driver's licence No. D01-0098424 will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of two (2) years;
- (2) prior to each of the next two renewals of the licence, Mr. Homer must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Mr. Homer incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Highway Traffic Act*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has any concerns with any new charges or convictions under the *Highway Traffic Act*, those matters and report No. 5684 and any updating material may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

**7. Naveed Muhammad** (*Report No. 5656*)

Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-3364009.

The application was withdrawn by the licensee, Mr. Naveed Muhammad.

**8. Aamir Yosef** (*Report No. 5592*)

Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-3245899.

The Tribunal approved the following joint recommendation:

Aamir Yosef's taxicab driver's licence No. D01-3245899 will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be suspended for a period of ten (10) days;
- (2) immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years;
- (3) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Yosef must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record;

- (4) during the probationary period, if Mr. Yosef incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Highway Traffic Act* or the *Criminal Code* he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (5) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has any concerns with any new charges or convictions under the *Highway Traffic Act*, the *Criminal Code* or the Toronto Municipal Code, those matters and report No. 5592 and any updating material may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

The Tribunal ordered Mr. Yosef to surrender his licence and photo ID to Municipal Licensing and Standards.
