
TORONTO LICENSING TRIBUNAL: March 15, 2012

Summary of Decisions

Peacock / Agrawal / Chan

1. Estate of Yan Groisman (*Report No. 5805*)

Divad Groisman, Trustee

Holder of Taxicab Owner's Licence No. V02-4179054, Plate No. 2946.

The Tribunal adjourned this matter to May 3, 2012, *peremptory* to the Estate and extended taxicab owner's licence No. V02-4179054, plate No. 2946, in the Estate of Yan Groisman, in the interim (up to May 3, 2012).

2. Varatharasan Maheswaran (*Report No. 5563*)

Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-2024008.

The Tribunal denied the renewal of Varatharasan Maheswaran's taxicab driver's licence No. D01-2024008.

The Tribunal ordered Mr. Maheswaran to surrender his licence and photo ID to Municipal Licensing and Standards by 4:00 p.m. today (March 15, 2012).

3. Total Home Improvement (*Report No. 5612*)

John Ricco, President

Applicant for a Building Renovator's Licence (Application No. B178726).

The Tribunal approved the following joint recommendation:

Total Home Improvement's application (No. B178726) for a building renovator's licence will be granted, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being issued, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of six (6) months;
- (2) prior to the completion of the probationary period (by September 15, 2012), Mr. Ricco must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his criminal record check;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Mr. Ricco incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Criminal Code*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and

- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has any concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5612 and any updating material may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

4. Hussein Elmi (Report No. 5719)
Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-3839918.

The Tribunal adjourned this matter to May 3, 2012, *peremptory* to Mr. Elmi.
(Mr. Elmi failed to attend today's hearing.)

The Tribunal ordered that a new notice be sent to the applicant.

5. Blushberry Inc., o/a Blushberry (Report No. 5607)
Richard Lande, Officer
Applicant for Renewal of Retail Store (Food) Licence No. B50-3961690.

The request for a hearing was withdrawn by the Corporation as it is no longer in business.

6. Uyen Phan Trieu (Report No. 5683)
Applicant for a Burlesque Entertainer's Licence (Application No. B180804).

The Tribunal approved the following joint recommendation:

Uyen Phan Trieu's application (No. B180804) for a burlesque entertainer's licence will be granted, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being issued, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of four (4) years;
- (2) prior to each of the next four renewals of the licence, Ms. Trieu must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at her own expense, an updated abstract of her criminal record check;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Ms. Trieu incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Criminal Code*, or the *Controlled Drug and Substances Act*, she must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has any concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5683 and any updating material may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

7. **Waqas Ali** (*Report No. 5680*)

Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-3487408.

The Tribunal denied the renewal of Waqas Ali's taxicab driver's licence No. D01-3487408.

The Tribunal ordered Mr. Ali to surrender his licence and photo ID to Municipal Licensing and Standards by April 15, 2012.
