1. **Mistre-Tegegn Gebre-Kidan** (*Report No. 5593*)
Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-3729214.

DECISION:

The Tribunal adjourned this matter to July 26, 2012, *peremptory* to Mr. Gebre-Kidan; and suspended his licence in the interim.
(Mr. Gebre-Kidan did not attend today's hearing.)

2. **Solomon Melese** (*Report No. 5701*)
Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-3837152.

DECISION:

The Tribunal adjourned this matter to May 31, 2012.

3. **Kulwant Singh** (*Report No. 5662*)
Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-2001321.

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following joint recommendation:

Kulwant Singh's taxicab driver's licence No. D01-2001321 will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years;
- (2) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Singh must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Mr. Singh incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Highway Traffic Act*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and

- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has any concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5662 and any updating material may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

4. Mahbub Sarder (*Report No. 5576*)
Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-3362471.

DECISION:

The Tribunal renewed Mahbub Sarder's taxicab driver's licence No. D01-3362471, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of two (2) years;
- (2) prior to each of the next two renewals of the licence, Mr. Sarder must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Mr. Sarder incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Highway Traffic Act*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has any concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5576 and any updating material may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

5. Kumanatasan Ponnuthurai (*Report No. 5653*)
Applicant for Renewal of Ambassador Taxicab Owner's Licence No. V02-3589041.

DECISION:

The Tribunal renewed Kumanatasan Ponnuthurai's Ambassador taxicab owner's licence No. V02-3589041, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years;
- (2) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Ponnuthurai must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record and his criminal record check;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Mr. Ponnuthurai incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Criminal Code*, or the *Highway Traffic Act*, he must notify

Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days;
and

- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has any concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5653 and any updating material may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

6. Tariq Ahmad (*Report No. 5643*)

Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-2001949.

DECISION:

The Tribunal renewed Tariq Ahmad's taxicab driver's licence No. D01-2001949, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years;
- (2) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Ahmad must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Mr. Ahmad incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Highway Traffic Act*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has any concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5643 and any updating material may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.
