**TORONTO LICENSING TRIBUNAL: April 26, 2012**  
**Summary of Decisions****T. Yao / S. Agrawal / D. Peacock**

1. **Estate of Walter Kuz** (*Report No. 5840*)  
Paula Anne Butterfield - Executrix  
Holder of Taxicab Owner's Licence Nos. V02-4182105 & V02-4182106 (for plate Nos. 364 & 2877).

**DECISION:**

The Tribunal extended taxicab owner's licence Nos. V02-4182105 and V02-4182106 for plate Nos. 364 and 2877 in the Estate of Walter Kuz for a period of three (3) months (up to July 16, 2012).

2. **Zaya Kyaw** (*Report No. 5786*)  
Applicant for a Taxicab Driver's Licence (Application No. B185473).

**DECISION:**

The Tribunal approved the following joint recommendation:

Zaya Kyaw's application (No B185473) for a taxicab driver's licence will be granted, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being issued, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of two (2) years;
- (2) prior to each of the next two renewals of the licence, Mr. Kyaw must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, his updated criminal record check;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Mr. Kyaw incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Criminal Code*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within five (5) business days; and
- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has any concerns with any new charges or convictions under the *Criminal Code*, the *Highway Traffic Act* or the Toronto Municipal Code, those matters and report No. 5786 and any updating material may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

3. **Amir Malik** (*Report No. 5769*)  
Applicant for Renewal of Driving Instructor's Licence No. V11-4074416.

**DECISION:**

The Tribunal approved the following joint recommendation:

Amir Malik's driving instructor's licence No. V11-4074416 will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years;
- (2) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Malik must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, his updated criminal record check;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Mr. Malik incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Criminal Code*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within five (5) business days; and
- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has any concerns with any new charges or convictions, under the *Criminal Code*, the *Highway Traffic Act* or the Toronto Municipal Code, those matters and report No. 5769 and any updating material may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

4. **Brook Restoration Ltd.** (*Report No. 5753*)  
Geoffrey Grist - President  
Applicant for a Building Renovator's Licence (Application No. B179035).

**DECISION:**

The Tribunal granted Brook Restoration Ltd.'s application (No. B179035) for a building renovator's licence, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being issued, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years;
- (2) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Grist must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, his updated criminal record check;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Mr. Grist incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Criminal Code*, or there are any *Highway Traffic Act* charges or convictions for vehicles owned by Brook Restoration Ltd., he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within five (5) business days; and

- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has any concerns with any new charges or convictions, under the *Criminal Code*, the *Highway Traffic Act* or the Toronto Municipal Code, those matters and report No. 5753 and any updating material may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

**5. Kulwinder Singh (Report No. 5456)**

Holder of Taxicab Owner's Licence No. V02-3007201, Plate No. 496.

**DECISION:**

The Tribunal approved the following joint recommendation:

Kulwinder Singh's taxicab owner's licence No. V02-3007201, plate No. 496 will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be endorsed that Mr. Singh is not to drive the vehicle until April 26, 2015;
- (2) Mr. Singh must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record and his criminal record check within five (5) business days of April 26, 2015;
- (3) The following conditions will be placed on the licence commencing April 26, 2015:
  - (i) the licence will be placed on probation for a period of two (2) years;
  - (ii) prior to each of the next two renewals of the licence, Mr. Singh must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record and his criminal record check;
  - (iii) during the probationary period, if Mr. Singh incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Criminal Code*, or the *Highway Traffic Act*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within five (5) business days; and
  - (iv) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has any concerns with any new charges or convictions, under the *Criminal Code*, the *Highway Traffic Act* or the Toronto Municipal Code, those matters and report No. 5456 and any updating material may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.
