
TORONTO LICENSING TRIBUNAL: May 10, 2012**Summary of Decisions****L. Miskin / K. Chan / D. Peacock**

1. Estate of Giuseppe Rea (Report No. 5843)

Mr. Nicholas Rea – Trustee

Mr. Valentino Rea – Trustee

Holder of Taxicab Owner's Licence No. V02-4181395, for Taxicab Plate No. 769.

DECISION:

The Tribunal extended taxicab owner's licence No. V02-4181395, plate No. 769 in the Estate of Giuseppe Rea up to August 16, 2012, to allow the estate time to sell the plate.

2. Select Windows and Doors Group Inc. (Report No. 5820)

Applicant for a Building Renovator's Licence (Application No. B064289).

DECISION:

The Tribunal adjourned this matter *sine die*.
(Mr. Rambhajue did not attend today's hearing.)

3. Asim Shabbir (Report No. 5817)

Applicant for a Taxicab Driver's Licence (Application No. B187621).

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following joint recommendation:

Asim Shabbir's application (No. B187621) for a taxicab driver's licence will be granted, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being issued, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of two (2) years;
- (2) prior to each of the next two renewals of the licence, Mr. Shabbir must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record;

- (3) during the probationary period, if Mr. Shabbir incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Highway Traffic Act* or driving charges or convictions in any other province, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within five (5) business days; and
- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has any concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5817 and any updating material may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

4. Khalil-Ur Rehman (*Report No. 5693*)

Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-3589662.

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following joint recommendation:

Khalil-Ur Rehman's taxicab driver's licence No. D01-3589662 will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being renewed the licence will be suspended for one (1) day;
- (2) immediately upon being re-instated, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years;
- (3) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Rehman must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record;
- (4) during the probationary period, if Mr. Rehman incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Highway Traffic Act*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within five (5) business days; and
- (5) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has any concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5693 and any updating material may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

The Tribunal ordered Mr. Rehman to surrender his licence and photo card to Municipal Licensing and Standards by 4:00 p.m. today (May 10, 2012)

5. Yohanes Melaku (*Report No. 5730*)

Applicant for a Taxicab Driver's (Lapsed) Licence (Application No. B074020).

DECISION:

The Tribunal granted Yohanes Melaku's application (No. B074020) for a taxicab driver's licence, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being issued, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of five (5) years;
- (2) Mr. Melaku must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record, every six months starting from the date the licence is issued;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Mr. Melaku incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Highway Traffic Act* or the Toronto Municipal Code, including any convictions on charges still pending, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has any concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5730 and any updating material may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

6. **Zafar Khan** (*Report No. 5767*)
Applicant for a Taxicab Driver's (Lapsed) Licence (Application No. B182001).

DECISION:

The Tribunal adjourned this matter to July 19, 2012.
(Mr. Khan failed to attend today's hearing.)

The Tribunal requested that a new notice of hearing be served to Mr. Khan and his counsel, Mr. T. Crawford, who may or may not be retained.
