
TORONTO LICENSING TRIBUNAL May 17, 2012

1. **Mohammad Rizwan Raja** (*Report No. 5628*)
Applicant for a Taxicab Driver's Licence (Application No. B177967).

DECISION:

The Tribunal adjourned this matter to June 7, 2012.
(Mr. Raja did not attend today's hearing.)

2. **Abdul Shaikh** (*Report No. 5613*)
Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-3728134.

DECISION:

The Tribunal adjourned this matter to July 5, 2012.
(Mr. Shaikh failed to attend today's hearing.)

3. **Muhammad Naveed Islam** (*Report No. 5777*)
Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-3369817.

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following joint recommendation:

Muhammad Naveed Islam's taxicab driver's licence No. D01-3369817 was renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years;
- (2) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Islam must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Mr. Islam incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Highway Traffic Act* or the Toronto Municipal Code, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within five (5) business days; and

- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has any concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5777 and any updating material may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

4. **Mohammad Raza Naqvi** (*Report No. 5794*)
Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-3843847.

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following joint recommendation:

Mohammad Raza Naqvi's taxicab driver's licence No. D01-3843847 will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of two (2) years;
- (2) prior to each of the next two renewals of the licence, Mr. Naqvi must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Mr. Naqvi incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Highway Traffic Act*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within five (5) business days; and
- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has any concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5794 and any updating material may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

5. **Dino Gonzales** (*Report No. 5623*)
Applicant for a Tow Truck Driver's Licence (Application No. B177577)

DECISION:

The Tribunal adjourned this matter to July 5, 2012.

6. **Kent Connor** (*Report No. 5829*)
Holder of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-3729060.

DECISION:

The Tribunal revoked Kent Connor's taxicab driver's licence No. D01-3729060, effective immediately.

7. **Syed Hassan** (*Report No. 5830*)
Holder of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-4063671.

DECISION:

The Tribunal renewed Syed Hassan's taxicab driver's licence No. D01-4063671, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be suspended for a period of seven (7) days, up to May 23, 2012;
- (2) immediately upon being re-instated, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years;
- (3) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Hassan must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record;
- (4) during the probationary period, if Mr. Hassan incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Highway Traffic Act* or the Toronto Municipal Code, including any convictions on charges still pending, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (5) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has any concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5830 and any updating material may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

The Tribunal ordered Mr. Hassan to surrender his licence and photo card ID to Municipal Licensing and Standards immediately.
