
TORONTO LICENSING TRIBUNAL: May 31, 2012
Summary of Decisions
S. Agrawal / K. Chan / T. Yao

1. **Solomon Melese** (*Report No. 5701*)
Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-3837152.

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following joint recommendation, as amended:

Solomon Melese's taxicab driver's licence No. D01-3837152 will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be suspended for a period of one (1) day starting at noon today (May 31, 2012);
- (2) immediately upon being reinstated, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years;
- (3) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Melese must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record;
- (4) during the probationary period, if Mr. Melese incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Highway Traffic Act*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (5) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has any concerns with any new charges or convictions under the *Highway Traffic Act*, the *Criminal Code of Canada*, or the Municipal Code which raise a concern, those matters and report No. 5701, and any updating material, may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

The Tribunal ordered Mr. Melese to surrender his licence to Municipal Licensing and Standards by 12:00 noon today (May 31, 2012).

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following joint recommendation:

Saeed Ayerman's taxicab driver's licence No. D01-2020623 will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years;
- (2) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Ayerman must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Mr. Ayerman incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Highway Traffic Act*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards within three (3) business days; and
- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has any concerns with any new charges or convictions under the *Highway Traffic Act*, the *Criminal Code of Canada* or the *Municipal Code*, those matters and report No. 5401, and any updating material, may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

- 5. Ghulam Abbas Warrich (Report No. 5872)**
Holder of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-3368904.

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following joint recommendation, as amended.

The following conditions will be placed on Mr. Warrich's licence, effective immediately:

- (1) Mr. Warrich will attend the Toronto Municipal Licensing and Standards packages of classes related to customer service and human rights, at his own expense, within six (6) months of May 31, 2012.
- (2) Mr. Warrich is required to attend the Taxicab Driver Refresher Training Course, at his own expense, within six (6) months of May 31, 2012.
- (3) Mr. Warrich will undergo a medical examination by a qualified psychiatrist and obtain a written report from the psychiatrist related to his ability to carry on the business of a taxicab driver, at his own expense, within nine (9) months of May 31, 2012. Mr. Warrich will ensure that the psychiatrist forwards a copy of his written report directly to Municipal Licensing and Standards staff within nine (9) months of May 31, 2012.
- (4) If Mr. Warrich fails to comply with any of the above conditions, or if the psychiatrist's report raises a concern to Municipal Licensing and Standards' staff, then the matter, including Report No. 5872 and any updating material, will be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.
