
TORONTO LICENSING TRIBUNAL June 14, 2012**Summary of Decisions****K. Chan / S. Agrawal / D. Hall**

1. Estate of Mason Hoxha (Report No. 5869)

Mr. Vivian Prem Wasta, Estate Trustee

Holder of Taxicab Owner's Licence Nos. V02-4291609 and V02-4291610, Taxicab Plate Nos. 1518 and 2956.

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the extension of taxicab owner's licence Nos. V02-4291609 and V02-4291610, for Plate Nos. 1518 and 2956, in the Estate of Mason Hoxha until August 31, 2012.

2. Harold C. Francis (Report No. 5602)

o/a Absolute Towing

Applicant for Renewal of Tow Truck Owner's Licence No. V10-3834323.

DECISION:

The Tribunal renewed Harold C. Francis' tow truck owner's licence No. V10-3834323, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being renewed the licence will be suspended for 24 hours;
- (2) immediately upon being re-instated, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of two (2) years;
- (3) prior to each of the next two renewals of the licence, Mr. Francis must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record and his criminal record check;
- (4) during the probationary period, if Mr. Francis incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Criminal Code*, the *Highway Traffic Act* or the Toronto Municipal Code, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (5) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has any concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5602 and any updating material may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

The Tribunal ordered Mr. Francis to surrender his licence and photo ID to Municipal Licensing and Standards immediately.

3. Emmanuel Frimpong (*Report No. 5639*)

Applicant for Renewal of Ambassador Taxicab Owner's Licence No. V02-3588624.

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following joint recommendation:

Emmanuel Frimpong's Ambassador taxicab owner's licence No. V02-3588624 will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being renewed the licence will be suspended for 3 days;
- (2) immediately upon being re-instated, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years;
- (3) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Frimpong must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record;
- (4) during the probationary period, if Mr. Frimpong incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Highway Traffic Act*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days;
- (5) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has any concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5639 and any updating material may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing; and
- (6) Mr. Frimpong must complete the customer service course offered by the City within the next three (3) months.

The Tribunal ordered Mr. Frimpong to surrender his licence and photo ID to Municipal Licensing and Standards by 10:00 a.m. on June 15, 2012; and pick them up on June 18, 2012 at 10:00 a.m.

- (1) immediately upon being renewed and issued, the licences will be placed on probation for a period of one (1) year;
- (2) during the probationary period, if 7-Eleven incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Municipal Code*, it must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within five (5) business days; and
- (3) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has any concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5589 and any updating material may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.
