**TORONTO LICENSING TRIBUNAL June 21, 2012****Summary of Decisions****D. Peacock / K. Chan / T. Yao**

**1. Standard Parking of Canada Ltd. (Report No. 5611)**

Applicant for Renewal of Public Garage (Parking Lot) Licence Nos. B77-3137808, B77-3250496, B77-3960426, B77-3137811, B77-3137815, B77-3137816, B77-4065004, B77-3137810 and B77-3592064.

**DECISION**

The Tribunal approved the following joint recommendation:

Standard Parking of Canada Ltd.'s public garage (parking lot) licence Nos. B77-3137808, B77-3250496, B77-3960426, B77-3137811, B77-3137815, B77-3137816, B77-4065004, B77-3137810 and B77-3592064 will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being renewed, the licences will be placed on probation for a period of one (1) year;
- (2) during the probationary period, if the corporation incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Municipal Code*, it must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within five (5) business days; and
- (3) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has any concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5611 and any updating material may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

**2. Milan Zapletal (Report No. 5741)**

Applicant for Renewal of Ambassador Taxicab Owner's Licence No. V02-3477203.

**DECISION**

The Tribunal approved the following joint recommendation:

Milan Zapletal's Ambassador taxicab owner's licence No. V02-3477203 will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being renewed, the licences will be placed on probation for a period of two (2) years;

- (2) during the probationary period, if Mr. Zapletal incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Highway Traffic Act* or the *Municipal Code*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within five (5) business days;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has any concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5741 and any updating material may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing; and
- (4) Mr. Zapletal has agreed to attend and complete the Customer Service component of the Taxicab Driver Training Course offered by the City, at his own expense, within the next three months.

**DECISION**

The Tribunal approved the following joint recommendation:

The following conditions will be placed on Orville Bloomfield's Ambassador taxicab owner's licence No. V02-3133014, effective immediately:

- (1) The licence will be suspended for two (2) days commencing at 10:00 a.m. on June 25, 2012; and

- (2) All the conditions placed on Mr. Bloomfield's licence by the Tribunal on September 8, 2011 will commence and continue for a four (4) year period from today's date (June 21, 2012).
