
TORONTO LICENSING TRIBUNAL: July 12, 2012
Summary of Decisions

1. **Brother's Cleaners Ltd.** (*Report No. 5800*)
o/a Stanley's Cleaners
Fortunato Fusco, President
Applicant for Renewal of Laundry Licence No. B57-0004432.

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following joint recommendation:

Brother's Cleaners Ltd.'s laundry licence No. B57-0004432 will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of one (1) year;
- (2) prior to the next renewal of the licence, Mr. Fusco must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his criminal record;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Mr. Fusco incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Criminal Code*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within five (5) business days; and
- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has any concerns with any new charges or convictions under the *Criminal Code*, those matters and report No. 5800, and any updating material, will be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

2. **Muhammad Sher Iqbal** (*Report No. 5755*)
Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-3598125.

DECISION:

The Tribunal renewed Muhammad Sher Iqbal's taxicab driver's licence No. D01-3598125, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years;
- (2) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Iqbal must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Mr. Iqbal incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Highway Traffic Act*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within five (5) business days; and
- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has any concerns with any new charges or convictions under the *Highway Traffic Act*, those matters and report No. 5755, and any updating material, will be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

3. **Mortimer Meertins** (*Report No. 5743*)
Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-3834066.

DECISION:

The Tribunal renewed Mortimer Meertins' taxicab driver's licence No. D01-3834066, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years;
- (2) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Meertins must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, an updated abstract of his driving record;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Mr. Meertins incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Municipal Code* or the *Highway Traffic Act*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within five (5) business days; and
- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions under the *Municipal Code*

or *Highway Traffic Act*, those matters and report No. 5743, and any updating material, will be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

4. **Ruben Feliz Soto** (*Report No. 5799*)
o/a Alberto Barbershop
Applicant for Renewal of Hair Salon Licence No. B56-3613278.

DECISION:

The Tribunal adjourned this matter to September 27, 2012, *peremptory* to Mr. Soto.
