
TORONTO LICENSING TRIBUNAL: July 19, 2012
Summary of Decisions

1. **Best Concrete and Drains Inc.** (*Report No. 5809*)
Paulo Medeiros, Officer of the Corporation
Applicant for Renewal of Drain Contractor's Licence No. T87-3080307.

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following joint recommendation:

Best Concrete and Drains Inc.'s drain contractor's licence No. T87-3080307 will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of two (2) years;
- (2) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Medeiros must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his criminal record;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Mr. Medeiros incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Criminal Code*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions under the *Criminal Code*, those matters and report No. 5809, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

2. **Apapa Tino Matembe** (*Report No. 5795*)
Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-3599406.

DECISION:

The Tribunal renewed Apapa Tino Matembe's taxicab driver's licence No. D01-3599406, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of two (2) years;

- (2) prior to each of the next two renewals of the licence, Mr. Matembe must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Mr. Matembe incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Highway Traffic Act* or the *Toronto Municipal Code*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new *Highway Traffic Act* or the *Toronto Municipal Code* charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5795, and any updating material, may be brought back to the Tribunal for a full hearing.

3. **Zafar Khan** (*Report No. 5767*)
Applicant for a Taxicab Driver's (Lapsed) Licence (Application No. B182001).

DECISION:

The Tribunal denied Zafar Khan's application (No. B182001) for a taxicab driver's (lapsed) licence.

4. **Syed Raza Shah** (*Report No. 5810*)
Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-3370968.

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following joint recommendation:

Syed Raza Shah's taxicab driver's licence No. D01-3370968 will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) the licence will be suspended for a period of three (3) days commencing Friday, July 20th, 2012;
- (2) immediately upon being reinstated, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years;
- (3) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Shah must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record;
- (4) during the probationary period, if Mr. Shah incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Highway Traffic Act*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and

- (5) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions under the *Highway Traffic Act*, those matters and report No. 5810, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

Mr. Shah is to surrender his licence and photo card to Municipal Licensing and Standards on Friday, July 20th, 2012.

5. Andy Amaral (*Report No. 5692*)
Applicant for a Tow Truck Driver's Licence (Application No. B181006)

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following joint recommendation:

Andy Amaral's application (No. B181006) for a tow truck driver's licence will be granted, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being issued, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years;
- (2) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Amaral must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record and his criminal record;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Mr. Amaral incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Highway Traffic Act*, the *Criminal Code* or the *Toronto Municipal Code*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions under the *Highway Traffic Act*, the *Criminal Code* or the *Toronto Municipal Code*, those matters and report No. 5692, and any updating material, may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.
