**1. Bloor Street Coffee Company Inc. (Report No. 5801)**

Applicant for Renewal of Eating Establishment Licence No. B71-4068788.

The Tribunal renewed Bloor Street Coffee Company Inc.'s eating establishment licence No. B71-4068788, effective immediately, subject to the following condition:

- the licence will be suspended for one day on September 24, 2012.

**2. Estate of Nick Longo (Report No. 5928)**

Holder of Taxicab Owner's Licence No. V02-4181395 for Taxicab Plate No. 769.

The Tribunal approved the following joint recommendation:

Taxicab owner's licence No. V02-4181395, plate No. 769, in the Estate of Giuseppe Rea will be extended for a period of thirty (30) days from today's date (September 6, 2012). The licence will be immediately suspended and the suspension will be lifted when the sale of the plate is finalized.

The Tribunal ordered that the licence and plate be surrendered to Municipal Licensing and Standards immediately.

**4. Shehbaz Malik** (*Report No. 5802*)

Applicant for Renewal of Limousine Driver's Licence No. D05-3844589.

The Tribunal adjourned this matter to September 27, 2012, *peremptory* to Mr. Malik and suspended Mr. Malik's licence in the interim.

The Tribunal ordered Mr. Malik to surrender his expired licence and photo card to Municipal Licensing and Standards by September 7, 2012.

**5. Whitfield Belasco** (*Report No. 5819*)

Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-2019731.

The Tribunal adjourned this matter to September 27, 2012, *peremptory* to Mr. Belasco and suspended Mr. Belasco's licence in the interim.

The Tribunal ordered Mr. Belasco to surrender his licence and photo card to Municipal Licensing and Standards immediately.
