
TORONTO LICENSING TRIBUNAL: September 13, 2012

Summary of Decisions

1. Abdullah Nur (*Report No. 5821*)

Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-3482492.

The Tribunal approved the following joint recommendation:

Abdullah Nur's taxicab driver's licence No. D01-3482492 will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) the licence will be placed on probation for a period of two (2) years from September 13, 2012;
- (2) prior to each of the next two renewals of the licence, Mr. Nur must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an original updated abstract of his driving record;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Mr. Nur incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Highway Traffic Act*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has any concerns with any new charges or convictions under the *Highway Traffic Act*, those matters and report No. 5821, and any updating material, may be brought back before the Tribunal for a hearing.

2. Abshir Ali Hassan (*Report No. 5905*)

Applicant for a Taxicab Driver's Licence (Application No. B188266).

The Tribunal approved the following joint recommendation:

Abshir Ali Hassan's application (No. B188266) for a taxicab driver's licence will be granted, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) the licence will be placed on probation for a period of one (1) year from September 13, 2012;
- (2) prior to the next renewal of the licence, Mr. Hassan must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an original updated abstract of his driving record;

- (3) during the probationary period, if Mr. Hassan incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Highway Traffic Act*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has any concerns with any new charges or convictions under the *Highway Traffic Act*, those matters and report No. 5905, and any updating material, may be brought back before the Tribunal for a hearing.

3. Balasubramaniam Senathirajah (*Report No. 5789*)
Applicant for Renewal of Driving Instructor's Licence No. V11-3112123.

The Tribunal adjourned this matter to December 6, 2012, on consent.

The Tribunal requested Mr. Freed to advise Municipal Licensing and Standards and the Tribunal office if the hearing can be scheduled for an earlier date.

4. Daniel Michael (*Report No. 5781*)
Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-3839838.

The Tribunal adjourned this matter to October 18, 2012, *peremptory* to Mr. Michael and suspended his licence in the interim, effective September 20, 2012.

The Tribunal ordered Mr. Michael to surrender his taxicab driver's licence and photo ID card to Municipal Licensing and Standards on September 20, 2012.

5. Tadesse Mekonnen (*Report No. 5876*)
Applicant for a Taxicab Driver's Licence (Application No. B186338).

The Tribunal denied Tedesse Mekonnen's application (No. B186338) for a taxicab driver's licence.

6. Tasios Mihas (*Report No. 5792*)
Applicant for a Tow Truck Driver's Licence (Application No. B189051).

The Tribunal denied Tasios Mihas' application (No. B189051) for a tow truck driver's licence.

7. Mohammed Sandhu (*Report No. 5661*)
Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-3948212.

The Tribunal renewed Mohammed Sandhu's taxicab driver's licence No. D01-3948212, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) the licence will be suspended for a period of two (2) months from September 13, 2012 and terminating on November 13, 2012;
- (2) immediately upon being re-instated, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of five (5) years;
- (3) prior to each of the next five renewals of the licence, Mr. Sandhu must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an original updated abstract of his driving record;
- (4) during the probationary period, if Mr. Sandhu incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Highway Traffic Act* or the *Toronto Municipal Code*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (5) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has any concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5661, and any updating material, may be brought back before the Tribunal for a hearing.
