**TORONTO LICENSING TRIBUNAL: September 27, 2012**  
**Summary of Decisions**

**1. Sabbirahmed Jogiyat** (*Report No. 5703*)

Applicant for a Hawker Pedlar with Motor Vehicle Licence (Application No. B182018).

**DECISION:**

The Tribunal approved the following joint recommendation:

Sabbirahmed Jogiyat's application (No. B182018) for a hawker pedlar with motor vehicle licence will be granted, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being issued, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years;
- (2) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Jogiyat must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Mr. Jogiyat incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Highway Traffic Act* or the *Toronto Municipal Code*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5703, and any updating material, may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

**2. Romulo Merchan** (*Report No. 5695*)

Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-0114171.

**DECISION:**

The Tribunal approved the following joint recommendation:

Romulo Merchan's taxicab driver's licence No. D01-0114171 will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years;
- (2) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Merchan must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record and his criminal record check;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Mr. Merchan incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Highway Traffic Act*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5695, and any updating material may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

3. **Ruben Feliz Soto** (*Report No. 5799*)

Applicant for Renewal of Hair Salon Licence No. B56-3613278.

**DECISION:**

The Tribunal adjourned this matter to November 1, 2012.

4. **Shehbaz Malik** (*Report No. 5802*)  
Applicant for Renewal of Limousine Driver's Licence No. D05-3844589.

**DECISION:**

The Tribunal approved the following joint recommendation:

Shehbaz Malik's limousine driver's licence No. D05-3844589 will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years;
- (2) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Malik must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Mr. Malik incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Highway Traffic Act* or the *Toronto Municipal Code*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and

- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5802, and any updating material, may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

**5. Whitfield Belasco** (*Report No. 5819*)

Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-2019731.

**DECISION:**

The Tribunal approved the following joint recommendation:

Whitfield Belasco's taxicab driver's licence No. D01-2019731 will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years;
- (2) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Belasco must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Mr. Belasco incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Highway Traffic Act* or the *Toronto Municipal Code*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5819, and any updating material, may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.
