
TORONTO LICENSING TRIBUNAL: October 4, 2012**Summary of Decisions****D. Hall / M. Borer / D. Peacock**

1. Firew Gedamu Wbenh (*Report No. 5850*)

Applicant for Renewal of Ambassador Taxicab Owner's Licence No. V02-3128758.

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following joint recommendation:

Firew Gedamu Wbenh's Ambassador taxicab owner's licence No. V02-3128758 will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years;
- (2) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Wbenh must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Mr. Wbenh incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Highway Traffic Act* or the *Toronto Municipal Code*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5850, and any updating material, may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

2. Marisa Inacio (*Report No. 5929*)

Applicant for Burlesque Entertainer's Licence (Application No. B299636).

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following joint recommendation:

Marisa Inacio's application (No. B299636) for a burlesque entertainer's licence will be granted, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being issued, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of two (2) years;

- (2) prior to each of the next two renewals of the licence, Ms. Inacio must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at her own expense, an updated criminal record check;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Ms. Inacio incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Criminal Code* or the *Toronto Municipal Code*, she must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5929, and any updating material, may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

DECISION:

- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5852,

and any updating material may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.
