
TORONTO LICENSING TRIBUNAL: October 18, 2012**Summary of Decisions****L. Miskin / S. Agrawal / K. Chan**

1. **Fiker Woubishet Workenh** (*Report No. 5893*)
Applicant for renewal of taxicab driver's licence No. D01-3591269.

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following joint recommendation:

Fiker Woubishet Workenh's taxicab driver's licence No. D01-3591269 will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years commencing October 18, 2012;
- (2) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Workenh must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Mr. Workenh incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Highway Traffic Act*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5893, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

2. **Sivakumaran Krishnapillai** (*Report No. 5531*)
Applicant for renewal of taxicab driver's licence No. D01-2015285.

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following joint recommendation:

Sivakumaran Krishnapillai's taxicab driver's licence No. D01-2015285 will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years commencing October 18, 2012;
- (2) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Krishnapillai must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Mr. Krishnapillai incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Highway Traffic Act*, or the *Criminal Code* he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5893, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

3. 2169116 Ontario Inc. (Report No. 5882)

Applicant for a driveway paving contractor's licence (Application No. B294630).

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following joint recommendation:

2169116 Ontario Inc.'s application (No. B294630) for a Driveway Paving Contractor's Licence will be granted, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years commencing October 18, 2012;
- (2) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Domenic Figliano, president of the applicant company, must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his Criminal Record;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Mr. Krishnapillai incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Criminal Code* he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and

- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5882, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

4. **Musawar Zafar** (*Report No. 5818*)

Applicant for renewal of taxicab driver's licence No. D01-3588681.

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following joint recommendation:

Musawar Zafar's taxicab driver's licence No. D01-3588681 will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) the licence will be suspended for a period of five (5) days commencing October 19th, 2012;
- (2) the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years, commencing October 18, 2012;
- (3) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Zafar must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record;
- (4) during the probationary period, if Mr. Krishnapillai incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Highway Traffic Act*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (5) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5818, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

5. **Imran Naveed** (*Report No. 5813*)

Applicant for renewal of taxicab driver's licence No. D01-3839229.

DECISION:

The Tribunal adjourned this matter to December 20th, 2012, *peremptory* to Mr. Naveed and suspended Mr. Naveed's licence in the interim.

6. **Waqar Ali** (*Report No. 5825*)
Holder of taxicab driver's licence No. D01-4180723.

DECISION:

The Tribunal adjourned this matter to December 13, 2012.

7. **Daniel Michael** (*Report No. 5781*)
Applicant for renewal of taxicab driver's licence No. D01-3839838.

DECISION:

The Tribunal denied Daniel Michael's application for the renewal of his taxicab driver's licence No. D01-3839838.
(Mr. Michael failed to attend today's hearing).

8. **Attiq Ur Rehman** (*Report No. 5835*)
Applicant for a Taxicab Driver's Licence (Lapsed) Licence (Application No. B187728).

DECISION:

The Tribunal granted Attiq Ur Rehman's application (No. B187728) for a taxicab driver's licence, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being issued, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years;
- (2) every six months from October 18th, 2012, Mr. Rehman must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Mr. Rehman incurs any new *Toronto Municipal Code* or *Highway Traffic Act* charges or convictions, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has any concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5835, and any updating material, may be brought before the Tribunal for a full hearing.
