**TORONTO LICENSING TRIBUNAL: October 25, 2012****Summary of Decisions****M. Borer / S. Agrawal / K. Chan**

**1. 1446256 Ontario Limited (Report No. 5750)**

**DECISION:**

The Tribunal approved the following joint recommendation:

1446256 Ontario Limited's eating establishment license No. B71-3611264 will be renewed and Lucky Tang Inc.'s application (No. B186328) for a retail store (food) licence will be granted, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions to be placed on both licenses:

- (1) immediately upon being renewed and issued, both licenses will be placed on probation for a period of five (5) years commencing October 25, 2012;
- (2) prior to each of the next five renewals of the licences, Mr. Sieu Dai Tang, president of the applicant companies, must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his criminal record;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Mr. Tang incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Criminal Code*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5750, and any updating material, can be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

2. **Joe Appiah** (*Report No. 5826*)  
Holder of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-0222412.

**DECISION:**

The Tribunal placed the following conditions on Joe Appiah's taxicab driver's licence No. D01-0222412, effective immediately:

- (1) the licence will be suspended for five (5) days.
- (2) immediately upon being reinstated, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years.
- (3) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Appiah must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record;
- (4) during the probationary period, if Mr. Appiah incurs any new charges or convictions under the Highway Traffic Act, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (5) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5826, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

The Tribunal ordered Mr. Appiah to surrender his licence and photo card to Municipal Licensing and Standards immediately (suspension to continue for 5 - 24 hour periods).

3. **Adib Abduraham Ibrahim** (*Report No. 5892*)  
Holder of Ambassador Taxicab Owner's Licence No. V02-3132746, Plate No. A519.

**DECISION:**

The Tribunal approved the following joint recommendation:

This matter will be adjourned *sine die* and Mr. Ibrahim's licence will be suspended in the interim.

4. **Ahmed Gaal** (*Report No. 5897*)  
Applicant for a Taxicab Driver's Licence (Application No. B292179).

**DECISION:**

The Tribunal adjourned this matter to a date in January 2013 to be scheduled by Tribunal staff, *peremptory* to the applicant.

5. **Francois Evala Kembi** (*Report No. 5833*)  
Applicant for a Taxicab Driver's Licence (Application No. B188359).

**DECISION:**

The Tribunal approved the following joint recommendation:

Francois Evala Kembi's application (No. B188359) for a taxicab driver's licence will be granted, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being issued, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years;
- (2) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Kembi must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, updated abstracts of his criminal record and driving record;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Mr. Kembi incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Highway Traffic Act* or the *Criminal Code*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has any concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5833 and any updating material, can be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

6. **Wajih Halabi** (*Report No. 5916*)  
Applicant for a Taxicab Driver's Licence (Application No. B293755).

**DECISION:**

The Tribunal denied Wajih Halabi's application (No. B293755) for a taxicab driver's licence.

7. **Nazaret Britsian** (*Report No. 5885*)  
Applicant for Renewal of Tow Truck Driver's Licence No. D09-3607450.

**DECISION:**

The Tribunal adjourned this matter to November 15, 2012.

- 8. Samuel K. Hoggar** (*Report No. 5732*)  
Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-2026118.

**DECISION:**

The Tribunal denied the renewal of Samuel Hoggar's taxicab driver's licence No. D01-2026118.
