
TORONTO LICENSING TRIBUNAL: November 1, 2012**Summary of Decisions****M. Borer / D. Hall / D. Peacock**

1. **Ephreme Seyefu Zegeye** (*Report No. 5766*)
Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-3370216.

DECISION:

The Tribunal adjourned this matter to February 7, 2013 and suspended Mr. Zegeye's licence in the interim.

(Mr. Zegeye did not attend today's hearing.)

2. **Ruben Feliz Soto** (*Report No. 5799*)
o/a Alberto Barbershop
Applicant for Renewal of Hair Salon Licence No. B56-3613278.

DECISION:

The Tribunal adjourned this matter to April 3, 2014 and placed the following conditions on the licence:

The Tribunal ordered the following conditions to be placed on the licence:

- (1) Mr. Soto is not permitted to cut hair in his own or any other hair cutting establishment;
- (2) during this period, if Mr. Soto incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Criminal Code* he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days;
- (3) if Municipal Licensing and Standards has any concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5799 and any updating material, may be brought back before the Tribunal on a date earlier than the April 3, 2014 adjournment date;
- (4) Mr. Soto is to pay the licence renewal fee due November 29, 2012.

3. **Muhammad Afzal** (*Report No. 5676*)
Applicant for Renewal of Ambassador Owner's Licence No. V02-3132763.

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following joint recommendation:

- (1) Muhammad Afzal's ambassador owner's licence No. V02-3132763 will be suspended immediately;
- (2) if the applicant pays all outstanding *Highway Traffic Act* and *Toronto Municipal Code* fines and provides staff of Municipal Licensing and Standards with proof of payment by January 7, 2013, Mr. Afzal's ambassador owner's licence shall be renewed and the suspension lifted on the day such proof of payment is provided, and the following conditions will be placed on the licence;
 - (i) immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three years from September 28, 2012;
 - (ii) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Afzal must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record;
 - (iii) during the probationary period, if Mr. Afzal incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Highway Traffic Act* or *Toronto Municipal Code*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days;
 - (iv) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has any concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5676 and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing; and
- (3) if Mr. Afzal fails to pay all outstanding *Highway Traffic Act* and *Toronto Municipal Code* fines by January 7, 2013, his ambassador owner's licence No. V02-3132763 will be cancelled.

The Tribunal ordered Mr. Afzal to surrender his licence and photo card to Municipal Licensing and Standards immediately.

4. **Sheraz Zubair** (*Report No. 5858*)
Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-3846495.

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following joint recommendation:

If Mr. Zubair pays all outstanding *Highway Traffic Act* and *Toronto Municipal Code* fines, his taxicab driver's licence No. D01-3846495 will be renewed, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years from November 1, 2012;
- (2) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Zubair must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Mr. Zubair incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Highway Traffic Act* or *Toronto Municipal Code*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days;
- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has any concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5858, and any updating material, may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing; and
- (5) Mr. Zubair shall provide proof of completion of a defensive driving course within three months of November 1, 2012.

5. **Edney Reid** (*Report No. 5780*)
Applicant for a Taxicab Driver's (Lapsed) Licence (Application No. B185793).

DECISION:

The Tribunal deemed this matter as abandoned.

6. **Umair Sheikh** (*Report No. 5735*)
Applicant for a Taxicab Driver's (Lapsed) Licence (Application No. B186685).

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following joint recommendation:

Umair Sheikh's application (No. B186685) for a taxicab driver's licence will be granted, effective immediately subject to the following conditions:

- (1) the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years commencing November 1, 2012;
- (2) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Sheikh must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at this own expense, updated abstracts of his criminal record and driving record;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Mr. Sheikh incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Criminal Code* or the *Highway Traffic Act*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5735, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.
