
TORONTO LICENSING TRIBUNAL: November 8, 2012**Summary of Decisions****S. Agrawal / M. Borer / K. Chan**

1. Hailu Desta (Report No. 5923)

Applicant for a Taxicab Driver's Licence (Application No. B295033).

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following pre-hearing agreement:

Hailu Desta's application (No. B295033) for a taxicab driver's licence will be granted effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being issued, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of two (2) years;
- (2) prior to each of the next two renewals of the licence, Mr. Desta must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Mr. Desta incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Highway Traffic Act*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5923, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

2. Shamsa Arshad (Report No. 5910)

Applicant for a Taxicab Driver's Licence (Application No. B190457).

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following pre-hearing agreement:

Shamsa Arshad's application (No. B190457) for a taxicab driver's licence will be granted, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years to commence on November 8, 2012;
- (2) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Ms. Arshad must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at her own expense, an updated abstract of her driving record;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Ms. Arshad incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Highway Traffic Act* or *Toronto Municipal Code*, she must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5910, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

3. Paramjit Singh Jammu (*Report No. 5737*)
Holder of Taxicab Owner's Licence No. V02-3084173.

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following pre-hearing agreement:

Paramjit Singh Jammu's driving privileges will be reinstated immediately with the following conditions:

- (1) his taxicab owner's licence will be placed on probation for a period of two (2) years to commence on November 8, 2012;
- (2) prior to each of the next two renewals of the licence, Mr. Jammu must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, a copies of his driver's record abstract and updated abstract of his criminal record;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Mr. Jammu incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Highway Traffic Act* and *Criminal Code*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any criminal charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5737 may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

4. **Yun Li** (*Report No. 5710*)
o/a Supreme Health & Beauty Center
Applicant for Renewal of Holistic Centre Licence No. B30-3594001 and Holistic Practitioner Licence No. T30-3840957.

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following joint recommendation:

Yun Li's holistic centre licence No. B30-3594001 and Holistic Practitioner Licence No. T30-3840957 will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) the licences will be suspended for a period of three (3) days from November 13th, 2012 to November 15, 2012;
- (2) the licences will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years, commencing November 8th, 2012;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Ms. Li incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Toronto Municipal Code*, she must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5710, and any updating material, may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

5. **Carlton Reid** (*Report No. 5880*)
Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-0075976.

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following joint recommendation:

Carlton Reid's taxicab driver's licence No. D01-0075976 will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being renewed, the licence will be placed on probation for three (3) years;
- (2) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Reid must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Mr. Reid incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Highway Traffic Act*, or the *Toronto Municipal Code* he

must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and

- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has any concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5880 and any updating material may be brought back to the Tribunal for a full hearing

- 6. Naushad Mohamed** (*Report No. 5752*)
Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-3835645.

DECISION:

The Tribunal denied the renewal of Naushad Mohamed's taxicab driver's licence No. D01-3835645.
