
TORONTO LICENSING TRIBUNAL: December 6, 2012**Summary of Decisions****K. Chan / M. Borer / D. Peacock**

1. **Balasubramaniam Senathirajah** (*Report No. 5789*)
Applicant for Renewal of Driving Instructor's Licence No. V11-3112123.

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following joint recommendation:

Balasubramaniam Senathirajah's driving instructor's licence will be renewed, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being renewed, the licence shall be suspended for seven (7) days commencing December 6, 2012;
- (2) immediately upon being re-instated, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years;
- (3) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Senathirajah shall provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record;
- (4) during the probationary period, if Mr. Senathirajah incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Highway Traffic Act* or *Criminal Code of Canada*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (5) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5789, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

The Tribunal ordered Mr. Senathirajah to surrender his licence and photo ID to Municipal Licensing and Standards.

2. **Samantha Lin Anderson** (*Report No. 5924*)
Applicant for a Burlesque Entertainer's Licence (Application No. B298016).

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following joint recommendation:

Samantha Lin Anderson's application (B298016) for a Burlesque Entertainer's licence, will be granted, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being issued, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of four (4) years;
- (2) prior to each of the next four renewals, Ms. Anderson shall provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at her own expense, an updated criminal record check;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Ms. Anderson incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Criminal Code*, she must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards within three (3) business days; and
- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has any concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and Report No. 5924 may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

3. **Lviv Ltd.** (*Report No. 5945*)
Roman Omelyanov Dmytriv, President
Applicant for a Public Garage Licence (Application No. B296138).

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the following joint recommendation:

Lviv Ltd.'s application (No. B296138) for a Public Garage Licence, will be granted, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being issued, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of four (4) years;
- (2) prior to each of the next four renewals of the licence, Mr. Dmytriv shall provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated criminal record;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Mr. Dmytriv incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Smoke Free Ontario Act* or the *Criminal Code*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards within three (3) business days; and
- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has any concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and Report No. 5945 may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

4. **Nurul Moral** (*Report No. 5783*)
Applicant for Renewal of Taxicab Driver's Licence No. D01-2022757.

DECISION:

The Tribunal adjourned this matter to January 10, 2013 *peremptory* to Mr. Moral.

5. **Nuno Bettencourt-Fernandes** (*Report No. 5691*)
Applicant for a Tow Truck Driver's Licence (Application No. B181139).

DECISION:

The Tribunal granted Nuno Bettencourt-Fernandes' application (No. B181139) for a tow truck driver's licence, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) immediately upon being issued, the licence will be placed on probation for a period of four (4) years;
- (2) prior to each of the next four renewals of the licence, Mr. Bettencourt-Fernandes' must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his criminal record and driving record;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Mr. Bettencourt-Fernandes incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Criminal Code*, *Highway Traffic Act* or *Toronto Municipal Code*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has any concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5691 and any updating material may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

6. **Estate of Nick Longo** (*Report No. 5979*)
Stanley A. Fromstein – Estate Trustee During Litigation
Holder of Taxicab Owner's Licence No. V02-4180398 for Taxicab Plate No. 1269.

DECISION:

The Tribunal extended taxicab owner's licence Nos. V02-4180398 for Taxicab Plate No. 1269 in the Estate of Nick Longo until January 31, 2013, preemptory, and ordered that the licence will be suspended in the interim as of midnight, Monday, December 10, 2012.

The Tribunal ordered the Estate of Nick Longo to surrender the licence plate to Municipal Licensing and Standards.
