

**TORONTO LICENSING TRIBUNAL: December 20, 2012****Summary of Decisions**T. Yao / K. Chan / D. Peacock

**Items 1 to 3 are Pre-Hearing Matters**

1. **Samuel Solomon** (*Report No. 5978*)  
Applicant for a Taxicab Driver's (Lapsed) Licence (Application No. B201769).

**DECISION:**

The Tribunal approved the following pre-hearing agreement:

Samuel Solomon's taxicab driver's licence will be granted, effective immediately, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) the licence will be placed on probation for a period of three (3) years to commence on December 20, 2012;
- (2) prior to each of the next three renewals of the licence, Mr. Solomon must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an updated abstract of his driving record;
- (3) during the probationary period, if Mr. Solomon incurs any new charges or convictions under the *Highway Traffic Act* or *Toronto Municipal Code*, he must notify Municipal Licensing and Standards, in writing, within three (3) business days; and
- (4) during the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions, those matters and report No. 5978, and any updating material, shall be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.

**DECISION:**
